
Any Which Way Quilt

Finished block size: 6" x 12" (large Flying Geese), 3" x 6" (small Flying Geese)

Finished quilt size: 72" x 84"

Backing: 5 1/8y (78" x 90"); Batting: 78" x 90"

Supplies and cutting directions:



Indah Batik 145- Dusty Peach (1y)

Cut for:

a. large Flying Geese

(3) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (14) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

b. small Flying Geese

(2) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.



Q4415-Ice Silver (1 3/4y)

Cut for:

a. large Flying Geese

(7) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles and (32) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

b. small Flying Geese

(2) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.



Q4413-Black Silver (3/4y)

Cut for:

a. large Flying Geese

(2) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (12) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

b. small Flying Geese

(3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.



Q4412-White Silver (1 1/4y)

Cut for:

a. large Flying Geese

(2) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (6) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

b. small Flying Geese

(3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

(3) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.



Q4414-Black Silver (3/4y)

Cut for

a. large Flying Geese

(2) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (6) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

b. small Flying Geese


(3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Tonal Indah Hand-dye 100-Denim (7/8y) Cut for a. small Flying Geese (2) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. b. binding (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
Tonal Indah Hand-dye 100-Sky (3/8y) Cut for a. small Flying Geese (3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
Q4416-Black Silver (1 1/4y) Cut for a. large Flying Geese (5) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (8) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles and (8) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. b. small Flying Geese (3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.
Tonal Indah Batik 114-Fog (1 7/8y) Cut for a. large Flying Geese (8) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (18) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" and (10) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. b. small Flying Geese (3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.
Q4414- White Silver (1 1/4y) Cut for a. large Flying Geese (6) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (10) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles and (14) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.
Indah Hand-print 153 Chalk (1 1/4y) Cut for a. large Flying Geese (3) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (14) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. b. small Flying Geese (6) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (64) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Indah Hand-print 154 Chalk (1y) Cut for a. small Flying Geese (3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (32) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares. (3) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
Indah Batik 113 Irongate (3/8y) Cut for a. small Flying Geese (3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Constructing large Flying Geese units

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" <fabric A> square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" <fabric B> rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal <fabric A> corner triangle. Repeat with another 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" <fabric A> square at the other opposite corner of the same 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" <fabric B> rectangle to complete (1) large Flying Geese unit.
- 2. Use the described method to make a total number of large Flying Geese units in the following fabric combinations, fabric used for corner triangle listed first.



Constructing small Flying Geese units

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" <fabric A> square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" <fabric B> rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal <fabric A> corner triangle. Repeat with another 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" <fabric A> square at the other opposite corner of the same 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" <fabric B> rectangle to complete (1) small Flying Geese unit.

Make a total of 16 units each for the following fabric combinations, fabric used for corner triangle listed first.

ink blot/denim	chalk/dusty pink	black leaf/irongate	black circular/sky
black star/white dandelion	fog/white bee	ink blot/sky	white dandelion/chalk


2. Arrange and sew together (4) small Flying Geese units together to make a row unit. Make (2) row units and sew them together to make (1) block, as shown.



Make a total of (8) blocks, and (8) mirror-imaged blocks. Set aside.

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Quilt Top is constructed by sewing large Flying Geese units and small Flying Geese blocks into pieced rows, and sewing the pieced rows to complete quilt top. Refer to row diagrams, arrange and sew together large flying geese units and small Flying Geese blocks to make a pieced row.



2. Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt top.

Finishing Instructions

- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then runner top to form quilt sandwich. Baste quilt sandwich.
- 2. Quilt as desired. Square up quilt before adding binding strip, hanging sleeve and label.
