

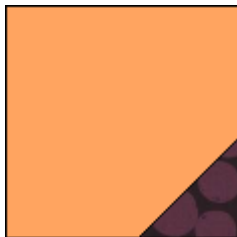

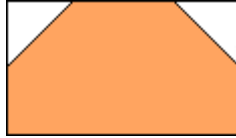

### Constructing flower block:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" 161-535 purple haze square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 4" x 4" **fabric** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal purple haze corner triangle.



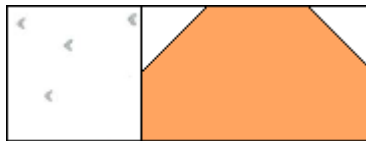
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" **fabric** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal background corner triangle. Repeat with another  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " background square at the opposite corner along the same long side of the same triangle to complete sewn unit. Make a total of (2) sewn units.



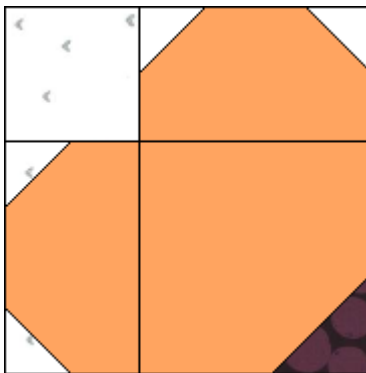
3. Sew (1) sewn unit made in step 2 and (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background square to make a row unit.



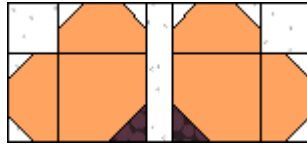
Sew together remaining sewn unit made in step 2 and sewn unit made in step 1 to make a row unit.



Sew together row units to make (1) block quadrant. Make a total of (4) block quadrants.



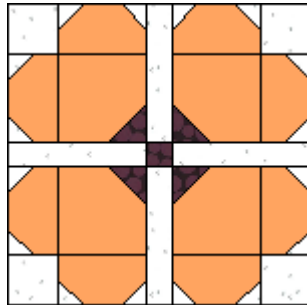
4. Sew (2) block quadrants to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 1/2" x 6" background rectangle to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.



Sew (2) 2 1/2" x 6" background rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" 161-535 purple haze square to make a row unit.



Sew together row units to complete (1) flower block.



5. Make a total number of flower blocks for the following **fabrics**:

2 blocks: 1895-Hollyhock, R4607-Blush, R4608 Black Cherry, R2223-Cotton Candy, R4610 Breeze, R4609-178 leaf

3 blocks: R2222-Taffy, R2207-Rum Raisin

### Constructing leaf blocks

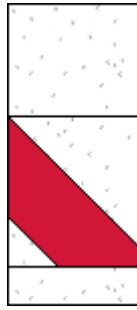
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 5 3/4" x 5 3/4" background square. Place square, right sides together at a corner of (1) 5 3/4" x 6 1/2" **fabric** rectangle. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal background corner triangle. Repeat with another 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" background square at the diagonally opposite corner of the same **fabric** rectangle to make a leaf unit.



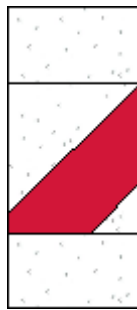
Make a mirror-image leaf unit.



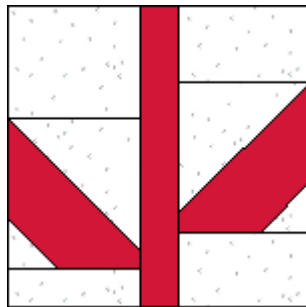
2. Sew (1) 5" x 5 3/4" background rectangle to the top, and (1) 2" x 5 3/4" background rectangle to the bottom of (1) leaf unit to make left section, as shown.



Sew (2) 3 1/2" x 5 3/4" background rectangles to top and bottom of mirror-image leaf unit to make right section, as shown.



3. Sew left and right sections to the opposite long sides of (1) 2" x 12 1/2" **fabric** rectangle to complete (1) leaf block.



4. Make a total number of blocks for the following **fabrics**:

4 blocks: 885-Taffy, 1895-Belle, R2218-Thistle

3 blocks: R4609-Leaf

2 blocks: 885-Clouds



## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Pieced columns. Refer to quilt image for block placement, arrange and sew together (7) blocks to make (1) pieced column.

Columns 1, 3, 5: (4) flower blocks and (3) leaf blocks

Columns 2, 4: (4) leaf blocks and (3) flower blocks

2. Sew together pieced columns and (4) 2 1/2" x 84 1/2" background sashing strips to complete quilt top.
