Fox and Tracks

Please Read and Follow Instructions Carefully to Ensure a Successful Project! Cutting Instructions: *Did you know?

- A. Panel or Theme Fabric (P4358-293)*: Centering Design, cut 26 1/2" x 40 1/2"
- B. Panel Frame / Inner Border (885-D7):
 Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF* strips
 Subcut (3) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips
 Set aside remaining strips for side inner border
- C. Fox Track Four Patches (1895-414, 1895-594):
 Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips from EACH of 2 fabrics, one light and one dark
- D. Fox Tracks Half Square Triangles (1384-174, 885-461):
 Cut (1) 6" x WOF strip from EACH of 2 fabrics, one light and one dark
 Subcut (4) 6" x 6" squares from each strip. Total (8) 6" x 6" squares
- E. <u>Outer Border (1384-612):</u> Cut (6) 2 1/2" WOF strips
- F. <u>Binding (1384-612):</u> Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF

*WOF = Width of Fabric From Selvage to Selvage

Note: All measurements are based on a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

Piecing Instructions:

Panel Border:

Using (2) (B) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2"
Panel Border strips, join to <u>Top</u>
and <u>Bottom</u> of Panel Fabric.
See Diagram 1.
Press seams toward Border
Strips. Your center will now measure 40 1/2" x 30 1/2" if using a 26 1/2" x 40 1/2" vertical panel.



Piecing Continued:

Fox Track Blocks:


Half Square Triangles:

Following Diagram 2, below, take one (B) Fox Track 6" square Dark fabric and one (B) Fox Track Light 6" square fabric. Place the (B) Fox Track 6" square Dark fabric right sides together with a (B) Fox Track 6" square Light fabric. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of diagonal line. Cut squares on diagonal line to create two half square triangle blocks. Press seams toward Darker fabric. Square down blocks (center diagonal stitching line with diagonal line on ruler running corner to corner and trim) to 5 1/2". Repeat using remaining 6" Dark and 6" Light Fox Track fabrics. Make (8) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" Half Square Triangle Blocks.




Four Patch Blocks:


Following Diagram 3, below, join a (C) Dark 3" x WOF strip to a (C) Light 3" x WOF strip. Press seam toward darker fabric. Make (2) strip sets.



Next, cut each strip into (8) 3" x 5 1/2" segments for a total of (16) segments. Following Diagram 4, join (2) segments together as shown creating a Four Patch. Make (8) Four Patch Blocks. Four Patch block will measure 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".




Following Diagram 5, join Half Square Triangle Blocks and Four Patch Blocks into rows. Make (2) rows. Attach your two rows to the bottom of Panel segment created on Pg. 1. Top will now measure 46 1/2" x 42 1/2".



Layout Diagram

After joining pieced blocks to panel section, join a (B) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Panel/Inner border strip to bottom of pieced rows. Then following Border instructions, add side Inner Borders.



Borders:

To determine the length of the inner side borders, measure quilt through the middle from top to bottom. Using (B) 2 1/2" Inner Border strips, cut to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach border strips to sides of quilt. Press seams toward inner border.

To determine the length of the outer side borders, measure quilt through the middle from top to bottom. Using (E) 2 1/2" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach border strips to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer border. Next, measure quilt through the middle from side to side to determine the length of the top and bottom outer borders. Using remaining (E) 2 1/2" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach to the top and bottom of quilt and press seams toward outer border. Quilt will now measure 48.5" x 46.5" (if using a 26 1/2" x 40 1/2" center panel).

Quilting:

Sandwich quilt top with batting and backing. Baste layers together and quilt as desired to enhance design.

Binding:

Join together (F) 2 1/2" Binding strips and bind using your favorite method.
