## Piece all block bottoms

First sew all 26 popsicle stick units:
Sew a 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" stick fabric piece to 1 1/2" x 3 " background fabric piece. Press.

Repeat to make a total of 26.

## Sew all One Stick Block Bottoms:

Sew two 6" x 7" background pieces to either side of a popsicle stick unit. Press.

Repeat to make a total of 14 .


## Sew all Two Stick Block Bottoms:

Sew two popsicle stick units to either side of a 2 1/2" x 7 " background piece. Press.

Sew two 4 1/2" x 7" backgrounds pieces to either side of sewn fabric. Press.


Repeat to make a total of 6 .

## 5 Sew Block 1: Skinnysicles

A
Sew two 5" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of each 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" skinnysicle fabric $B$. Press.

Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2" background piece to the top. Press.


C
Sew a One Stick Block Bottom to bottom. Press.

D
Repeat to sew second Skinnysicle block with fabric M!


A
Start with a 312 " $\times 3$ $1 / 2$ " and a $31 / 2$ " x 6 $1 / 2$ " piece from each stripe color B \& L.

C
Draw line from top right to bottom left of square piece and sew directly on line. Trim 1/4" from seam line discarding upper left triangles. Open and press.

E
Draw line from top right to bottom left of square piece and sew directly on line. Trim 1/4" from seam line discarding bottom right triangles.
 Open and press.

G
Rotate TOP piece only $90^{\circ}$ CCW aligning bottom right corner.


Trim 1/4" from seam line discarding lower right triangles. Open and press.


## K

Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2" background piece to the top of unit. Press.

B
Place 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" piece of $L$ above $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ $61 / 2$ " piece of $B$. If your fabric is directional rotate square $90^{\circ} \mathrm{CW}$ first. Then flip down along short edge so that fabric is right sides together..

D
Place 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" piece of $L$ on top of 3 $1 / 2$ " x 3 1/2" piece of B. If your fabric is directional rotate square $90^{\circ} \mathrm{CW}$ first. Then flip up along short edge.


F
Place the two pieced sections one above the other in the order of your stripes with fabric B on top. Flip bottom piece up along short end placing fabric right sides together.


Draw line from top right to bottom left of square section that overlaps and sew directly on line.


Sew two 5" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of the Swirlsicle unit. Press.

(L)

Sew One Stick Block Bottom to bottom of block.

Repeat for second Swirlsicle block with fabrics D \& J.

Sew 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" background pieces to either end of 2" x 1 1/4" piece of
 fabric D. Press. Set aside.

Place 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" background fabric on either end of $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ $1 / 4$ " fabric D. Draw diagonal lines as shown in picture. Sew directly on lines. Trim 1/4" away from lines as shown in picture. Press.


Sew this to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of fabric 1 . Sew this to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ 1/2" fabric G. Press.

Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2" background piece to the top of unit. Press.
 background pieces to either side of the Space Pops unit. Press.

$\mathcal{P}$ Sew Block 4: Roundsicles

Place Cutting Guide B on top of 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" roundsicle fabric $P$ aligning sides and bottom. Use curved edge on top as a cutting guide and cut along curve.


Discard top two corner pieces.


C
Matching ends and center of curve, sew background fabric cut from Template A to top of cut roundsicle fabric. Press.
 background piece background piece Press.


D
Sew two 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of Roundsicle unit. Press.


E
Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2"
F
Sew Two Stick Block Bottom to bottom of block. Press.

Repeat to sew second Roundsicle with fabric B..


B
Place Cutting Guide B on top of pieced Double Dip Roundsicle unit aligning sides and bottom. Use curved edge on top as a cutting guide and cut along curve. Discard corners.


D
Sew two 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of each unit. Press.


Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2" background piece to the top of unit. Press.


F
Sew One Stick Block Bottom to bottom of block. Press.

Repeat to sew second Double Dip Roundsicle with fabrics B \& L.


Sew one 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" fabric O to top of $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric G. Sew 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" fabric $D$ to bottom. Press.


## C

Matching ends and center or curve, sew background fabric cut from Template A to top of Triple Roundsicle unit. Press.


E
Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2" background piece to the top of unit. Press.


## 11 Sew Block 7: Squaresicles

Sew two 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of Squaresicle fabric. Press.

Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2" background piece to the top of unit. Press.

Sew Two Stick Block Bottom to bottom of block. Press.

Repeat for second Squaresicle block with fabric D.

Place Cutting Guide B on top of pieced Triple Roundsicle unit aligning sides and bottom. Use curved edge on top as a cutting guide and cut out along curve. Discard corners.


Sew two 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of unit. Press.


Sew One Stick Block Bottom to bottom of block.

Repeat to sew second Triple Roundsicle with fabrics I, J, \& K.

Sew 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" fabric $O$ along long edge to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9$ 1/2" fabric D. Press.


C
Sew 12 1/2" x 3 1/2" background piece to the top of unit. Press.


## $\int$ Sew Block 9: Stripesicles

A
Starting with 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" fabric H alternate sewing with 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" fabric $J$ along long edge to form Stripesicle unit. Press.


B
Sew two 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of Stripesicle unit. Press.


D
Sew One Stick Block Bottom to bottom of block. Press.

Repeat to sew second Stripesicle block using fabric M \& E.


## $1 \nLeftarrow$ sew Block 10: 3-Flavor Squaresicles

A
Sew one 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" fabric G to top of $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 3 1/2" fabric E. Sew 6 $1 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric $P$ to bottom. Press.


B
Sew two 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" background pieces to either side of the 3-Flavor Squaresicle unit. Press.


## D

Sew One Stick Block Bottom to bottom of block. Press.

Repeat to sew second 3-Flavor Squaresicle block with fabric K, L \& D.
 15 Quilt Assembly

Using the diagram as a guide, sew blocks into four rows of five blocks each, then sew together rows to form quilt top.

Baste, quilt, and bind as desired!
