Made from 1 Hoffman Fabrics Jewel Pop...JLP 162G-Jewel Gold

Open the Pop very carefully, trying to keep in order.

Refer to Cutting Chart for cutting details

Construction

Use photo for suggested fabric placement.

Start with top row, sew single rows of strips together, interspersing the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares in between.

Continue with row 2. Sew rows 1 and 2 together, along long edges.

Match any intersecting seams.

Continue to piece single rows 3 and 4 and sew those together along long edges. Join rows 3 and 4 to rows 1 and 2.

Proceed with rows 5 and 6. After they have been joined, attach to bottom of previous rows.

Continue as above working in pairs of two rows.

After row 10, add single row of 2-24" sub-cuts and 1-pink 2 1/2" square. (Row 11)

Continue with rows 12-16. Attach to bottom of row 11. Put aside this top portion for now.

Start the second (bottom) section...when you get to row 5, of second section, sew 2 strips of 24" with a pink square between the 2 strips.

Proceed piecing the individual rows and then join rows together in pairs of two, ending with 15 rows for this bottom section.

Join bottom half to top.

It may be necessary to trim the left and right outer edges to even and straighten.

Layer backing, batting and pieced top. Quilt as desired. Bind and enjoy!
