





Finished Quilt Size: 57" x 69" Finished Block Size: 9" x 12"

Cutting Instructions:

Note: Dimensions of patches are listed in W" x L" (important when cutting from directional prints)

*From Fabric 1,

Cut for quilt center, (1) 12 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (4) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

For pieced inner border #4, (1) 6 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (3) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" and (4) 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

[Note: Fabric print is directional - rectangles need to be cut where the birch tree trunks are oriented vertically along the length of rectangles.

*From **Fabric 2**, cut for quilt center, (1) 12 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (4) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

For pieced inner border #4, (1) 6 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" and (5) 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

[Note: Fabric print is directional - rectangles need to be cut where the **Fabric 2** is oriented vertically along the length of rectangles.

*From **Fabric 3**, cut for sashing squares and pieced inner border #4, (1) 1 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (9) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares and (2) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

For inner border #2, (5) 1" x 42" WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 1" x 42 1/2" and (2) 1" x 53 1/2" strips.

For binding, cut (7) 2 1/4" strips and piece to make a continuous binding strip.

From **Fabrics 4 and 5**, cut for pieced inner border #4, (1) 6 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (3) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" and (4) 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

From **Fabric 6**, cut for pieced inner border #4, (1) 6 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (3) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" and (3) 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

From **Fabrics 7 and 8**, cut for quilt center, (1) 12 1/2" X 42" WOF. Sub-cut (4) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

*From **Fabric 9** background, cut for sashing rectangles, (1) 12 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (12) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" and (12) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

For inner border #1 (5) 1 1/2" x 42" WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 41 1/2" and (2) 1 1/2" x 51 1/2" strips.

For inner border #3, (3) 3 1/2" x 42" WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (1) 3 1/2" x 45 1/2" and (1) 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.

For pieced inner border #4 (7) 3 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 3 1/2" rectangles, and (68) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

For outer border, (6) 3 1/2" x 42" WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 57 1/2" and (2) 3 1/2" x 63 1/2" strips.

Quilt Center Assembly

Note: Instructions are written and shown for Green Colorway, but they are completely interchangeable for the Blue Colorway.

1. Pieced Rows. Arrange and sew together (4) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" print rectangles and (3) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" ground sashing rectangles to make a row.

2. Pieced sashing row. Arrange and sew (4) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" ground sashing rectangles and (3) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Fabric 3 squares to make a pieced sashing row. Repeat to make 3 pieced sashing rows.

3. Sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows together to complete quilt center.




Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 51 1/2" ground strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 41 1/2" ground strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1" x 53 1/2" **Fabric 3** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 1" x 42 1/2" **Fabric 3** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.



3. Inner border #3. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" ground strip to the right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) 3 1/2" x 45 1/2" ground strip to the bottom of the quilt center.



4. Pieced inner border #4.

Flying geese units (using **Fabric 2** unit as example). Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" ground square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric 2** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal ground corner triangle. Repeat with another 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" ground square at the other corner of the same **Fabric 2** rectangle to complete 1 flying geese unit.




Repeat to make a total number of flying geese units in the following colorways (noting the orientation of the units made with directional prints):

7 units - Fabric 1, Fabric 2, Fabric 4, Fabric 5

6 units – Fabric 6

Tree trunk units. Sew (2) 3" x 3 1/2" ground rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric 3 rectangle to make a tree trunk unit.


Arrange and sew together 14 flying geese units and 1 tree trunk unit to make a row, as shown. Sew pieced row to the bottom of quilt center.



Arrange and sew together 20 flying geese units and 1 tree trunk unit to make a column, as shown. Sew pieced row to the right side of quilt center.



5. Outer border. Sew (2) 3 1/2" x 63 1/2" ground strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 3 1/2" x 57 1/2" ground strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions:

- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to finish quilt.
