## Constructing Pieced Blocks

1. Flying Geese and middle unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 3/4" Print I square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x 5" Fabric F rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal Print I corner triangle. Repeat with another $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 3/4" Print I square at the opposite corner of the same Fabric $F$ rectangle to make a Print I/Fabric F Flying Geese unit.

Repeat to make a total of (4) Flying Geese units for
Print I/Fabric F

Fabric F/Print II


Print II/Fabric A


Sew together Flying Geese of each fabric combination into (1) middle unit, as shown, below. Make a total of (4) middle units.

2. Corner units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{A}$ square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3 1/4" $\times 3$ 1/4" Fabric F square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ raw edge to raw edge.

Sew (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 3/4" Fabric A square to the right of (1) HST unit to make (1) unit B1.


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 3/4" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal Fabric A corner triangle, as shown, to make (1) unit B2.


Sew together units B 1 and B 2 to make unit B 3 .

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 4$ " Print II square. Place square, right sides together at a corner of (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal Print II corner triangle, as shown.


Sew unit to the right of unit B3 to make B4.


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 3/4" Print II square. Place square, right sides together at a corner of (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal Print II corner triangle, as shown.


Add (1) 2 3/4" $\times 2$ 3/4" Fabric A square to the right of unit made above, and add to the top of unit B4 to make (1) corner unit. Make a total of (2) corner units,

and (2) mirror-imaged corner units.

4. Sew (1) corner unit and (1) mirror-imaged corner unit to the opposite long sides of (1) middle unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.

5. Sew (2) middle units to the left and right sides of (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Print III square to make a row unit.

6. Sew together row units to complete (1) pieced block.

5. Make a total of number of blocks for the following Print III/Print I/Print II combinations:
4 blocks: $\mathbf{B} / \mathrm{E} / \mathrm{E}, \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{H}$
3 blocks: C/K/K, G/G/I
2 blocks: E/E/L

## Quilt center Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks and (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18$ 1/2"

Fabric A sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (4) pieced rows.
2. Pieced sashing rows. Arrange and sew together (4) 1 1/2" $\times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A sashing rectangles and (3) Fabric E cornerstones to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (3) pieced sashing row.
3. Sew together pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.


## Quilt top assembly

1. Inner border \#1. Sew (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 751 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{A}$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 781 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{A}$ strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
2. Inner border \#2. Sew (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 781 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 83$ 1/2" Fabric J strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
3. Inner border \#3. Sew (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 831 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $L$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 851 / 2 "$ Fabric $L$ strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
4. Outer border. Sew (2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 851 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 5 " $\times 941 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to finish quilt.
