

Stars and Stripes Forever

Quilt design and instructions by Wendy Sheppard

Approximate Finished Size: 67" x 82"

Block size: 15" square

Supplies:

- 1. 5/8 y: gray tonal (113 461-Irongate)
- 2. 2 y: gray star (P4295 619-Warm Gray)
- 3. 1 y: red star (P4295 83-Barn Red) includes binding
- 4. ½ y: flag (P4292 159-Americana)
- 5. 7/8 y: midnight firework (P4297 128-Midnight)
- 6. 7/8 y: license plate (P4294 159-Americana)
- 7. 1/2 y: blue star (P4295 65-Denim)
- 8. 3/4 y: white firework (P4297 3-White)
- 9. ½ y: large star (P4293 159-Americana)
- 10. 5/8 y: Prussian tonal (104 169-Prussian)
- 11. ¼ y: small star (P4296 3-White)
- 73"x 88" piece of backing fabric (5y)
- 73" x 88" piece of batting

Basic sewing notions and matching threads

Cutting Directions:

- 1. From gray tonal, cut for
- a. stripe blocks
- (2) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (5) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- b. small star blocks
- (1) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 2" squares, (2) 2" x 3 1/2" and (2) 2" x 11" rectangles.
- 2. From gray star, cut for
- a. stripe blocks
- (2) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- (2) 4" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 4" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- b. small star blocks
- (3) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (56) 2" x 2" squares.
- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (7) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.
- c. large star blocks
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (6) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- (4) 3" x WOF. Sub-cut (48) 3" x 3" squares.
- d. outer border
- (7) 4" x WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 4" x 67 1/2" and (2) 4" x 75 1/2" strips.
- 3. From red star, cut for
- a. stripe blocks
- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- b. small star blocks
- (4) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (7) 2" x 2" squares, (7) 2" x 3 1/2" and (7) 2" x 11" rectangles.

c. for binding cut (8) at 2 1/4" wide strips, and pieced using diagonal seams to make a continuous strip.

4. From flag, cut for small star blocks

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (2) 5 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- 5. From midnight firework, cut for
- a. stripe blocks
- (2) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- b. small star blocks
- (3) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (5) 2" x 3 1/2" and (5) 3 1/2" x 11" rectangles.
- c. large star blocks
- (2) 5 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" x 8" and (3) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles.
- 6. From license plate, cut for
- a. stripe blocks
- (2) 3" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- b. small and large star blocks
- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- (2) 5 ½" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 5 ½" x 15 ½" rectangles.
- 7. From blue star, cut for
- a. stripe blocks
- (2) 3" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 3" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- b. small star blocks
- (3) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 2" squares, (6) 2" x 3 1/2" and (4) 2" x 11" rectangles.
- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 11" rectangles.
- 8. From white firework, cut for
- a. stripe blocks, small and large star blocks

(1) 15 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2", (3) 4" x 15 1/2", (3) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" and (1) 5 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.

- b. small star block
- (1) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (1) 2" x 2" square, (1) 2" x 3 1/2" and (1) 2" x 11" rectangles.
- c. large star block
- (2) 3" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 3" x 3" squares, (3) 3" x 5 1/2" and (3) 3" x 8" rectangles.
- 9. From large star, cut for
- a. stripe blocks
- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.
- b. large star blocks
- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (6) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares.
- 10. From Prussian tonal, cut for
- a. large star blocks
- (5) 3" x WOF. Sub-cut (9) 3" x 3" squares, (12) 3" x 5 1/2" and (9) 3" x 8" rectangles.
- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (3) 5 1/2" x 8" rectangles.
- 11. From small star, cut for stripe blocks
- (2) 2" x WOF. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 15 1/2" rectangles.

Constructing Stripe Blocks

- 1. Stripe blocks are constructed by sewing rectangles together (from top to bottom):
- (1) 2" x 15 1/2"
- (1) 4" x 15 1/2"
- (1) 2" x 15 1/2"
- (1) 3" x 15 1/2"

(1) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2"


(1) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2"

2. Make a total number of blocks in the following colorways:

3 blocks



2 blocks



Constructing small star blocks

1. Flying Geese unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" gray star square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2" x 3 1/2" red star rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal gray star corner triangle. Repeat with another 2" x 2" gray star square at the other corner of the same 2" x 3 1/2" red star rectangle to compete 1 Flying Geese unit.



Use the same procedure to make a blue star and a gray tonal Flying Geese unit.





2. Sawtooth Star Unit.


a. Sew together (1) 2" x 2" red star square, (1) red star Flying Geese unit, and (1) 2" x 11" red star rectangle.



b. Sew together (1) 2" x 2" gray tonal square, (1) gray tonal Flying Geese unit, and (1) 2" x 11" gray tonal rectangle.




c. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" gray star square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3 1/2" x 11" blue star rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Repeat with another 2" x 2" gray star square at the adjacent corner of the same 3 1/2" x 11" blue star rectangle. Sew sewn unit to the right of (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" gray star square, following by the 1 blue star Flying Geese unit to the left of the same 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" gray star square.



d. Sew all the rows made in steps a-c to complete 1 Sawtooth Star unit.



3. Sew to the top of Sawtooth Star unit (1) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" white firework rectangle, followed by (1) 5 1/2" x 15 1/2" flag rectangle.




4. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorways:

2 blocks



1 block





Constructing large star blocks

1. Flying Geese unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $3" \times 3"$ gray star square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $3" \times 5 1/2"$ Prussian tonal rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal gray star corner triangle. Repeat with another $3" \times 3"$ gray star square at the other corner of the same $3" \times 5 1/2"$ Prussian tonal rectangle to compete 1 Flying Geese unit.



Repeat to make a total of 2 Prussian tonal and 1 white firework Flying Geese units.






2. Sawtooth star unit.

a. Sew together (1) 3" x 8" Prussian rectangle, (1) Prussian Flying Geese unit and (1) 3" x 3" Prussian square.



b. Sew together (1) 3" x 8" white firework rectangle, (1) white firework Flying Geese unit and (1) 3" x 3" white firework square.




c. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $3" \times 3"$ gray star square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $5 \frac{1}{2"} \times 8"$ Prussian tonal rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Open and press to reveal gray star corner triangle. Repeat with another $3" \times 3"$ gray star square at the adjacent corner of the same $5 \frac{1}{2"} \times 8"$ Prussian tonal rectangle to complete sewn unit.




Sew sewn unit and (1) Prussian Flying Geese unit to the opposite sides of (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" large star square.



d. Sew all the rows made in steps a-c to complete 1 Sawtooth Star unit.




3. Sew to the top of Sawtooth Star unit (1) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" white firework rectangle, and to the bottom (1) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" gray star rectangle to complete 1 large star block.



4. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorways:

1 block



2 blocks






Assembling Quilt Center

1. Arrange and sew 4 pieced blocks to make a pieced row.

Row 1










2. Sew all pieced rows together to complete quilt center.



Assembling Quilt Top

1. Outer border. Sew (2) $4" \times 75 1/2"$ gray star strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) $4" \times 67 1/2"$ gray star strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing/Quilting Instructions:

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste quilt sandwich.

- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Square up quilt before adding binding strip, hanging sleeve and label.
