

Fabrics and cutting directions: [Please note cutting with be somewhat tight, plan ahead before cutting.]



100-Zinc (2 5/8y)		Cut for: a. pieced blocks (5) 1 3/4" x WOF. Sub-cut (98) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares. (7) 6 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (196) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. b. outer vertical pieced sashing blocks (2) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (12) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. c. remaining vertical pieced sashing blocks (3) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (30) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. d. outer horizontal pieced sashing blocks (2) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. e. remaining horizontal pieced sashing blocks (2) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. e. remaining horizontal pieced sashing blocks (2) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (30) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. f. cornerstones (2) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (36) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. g. outer border (6) 3" x WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 3" x 53 1/2" and (2) 3" x 62 1/2" strips.


Block Construction

1. Draw a diagonal line on (1) $1 3/4" \times 1 3/4"$ background square. Place square, at a corner of (1) ruby print $2 1/2" \times 3 1/2"$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal background corner triangle. Make a total of (2) sewn units.

2. Sew together (2) previously sewn units and $(2) 2 1/2" \times 3 1/2"$ lime print rectangles to make block center. Block center measures $4 1/2" \times 6 1/2"$ raw edge to raw edge.



3, Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" background rectangles to the opposite long sides of block center, followed by (2) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" to the remaining opposite short sides of block center to complete (1)



block. Pieced block measures $6 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ raw edge to raw edge.

4. Make a total of (49) blocks using the following fabric combinations.


(8) blocks each: Ruby dot/Lime stripe; Ruby box/Lime speck; Ruby plaster/Lime ditsy; Ruby

ditsy/Lime ripple; Ruby chevron/Lime plaster

(9) blocks: Ruby stripe/Lime dot.

Constructing pieced sashing blocks:

1. Outer vertical pieced sashing units: Sew together (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ red ripple rectangle and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ background rectangle to complete (1) outer vertical pieced sashing unit. Make a total of (6) units.





2. Remaining vertical pieced sashing units: Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ red ripple rectangle and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ green box rectangle to the opposite short sides of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ background rectangle to complete (1) unit. Make a total of (30) unit.

3. Outer horizontal pieced sashing units: Sew together (1) 1 $1/2" \times 2 1/2"$ red speck rectangle and (1) 1 $1/2" \times 4 1/2"$ background rectangle to complete (1) outer horizontal pieced sashing unit. Make a total of (6) units.

Sew together (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" green chevron rectangle and (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" background rectangle to complete (1) outer horizontal pieced sashing unit. Make a total of (6) units.


4. Remaining horizontal pieced sashing units: Sew (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ red speck rectangles to the opposite short sides of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ background rectangle to complete (1) unit. Make a total of (15) units.

Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" green chevron rectangles to the opposite short sides of (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" background rectangle to complete (1) unit. Make a total of (15) units.

Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Sew together (7) pieced blocks, and (6) vertical sashing units (outer or remaining) to make a pieced row.


Row 1: (7) pieced blocks and (6) red ripples outer vertical sashing units.




Row 2: (7) pieced blocks and (6) remaining vertical sashing units.

Row 3: (7) pieced blocks and (6) remaining vertical sashing units.

Row 4: (7) pieced blocks and (6) remaining vertical sashing units.





Row 5: (7) pieced blocks and (6) remaining vertical sashing units.


Row 6: (7) pieced blocks and (6) remaining vertical sashing units.

Row 7: (7) pieced blocks and (6) green box outer vertical sashing units.

2. Pieced sashing rows. Sew together (2) outer horizontal sashing units, (5) remaining horizontal sashing units and (6) background 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" cornerstones to make a pieced sashing row. SR1, SR3, and SR5: (2) green chevron outer horizontal sashing units, (5) green chevron remaining horizontal sashing units and (6) background 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" cornerstones.


SR2, SR4, and SR6: (2) red speck outer horizontal sashing units, (5) red speck remaining horizontal sashing unitss and (6) background 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" cornerstones.

3. Sew together pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.



Quilt Top Assembly

1. Outer border. Sew (2) $3'' \times 62 1/2''$ background strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3'' \times 53 1/2''$ background strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



<u>Quilting Instructions</u>:

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.

- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to finish quilt.
