




Constructing House Blocks


Black houses on white colorway

1. Flying Geese units.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4" x 4" white circular square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 4" x 7 1/2" black print rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal white circular corner triangle. Repeat with another 4" x 4" white circular square at the other end of the same black print to complete (1) flying geese unit.

Make (8) black leaf and (13) black bee flying geese units.





2. House units. Sew (4) 1 1/2" x 2" black print and (3) 1 1/2" x 2" tonal rectangles to make a row.



Add (2) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" black print rectangles to the opposite long sides of sewn unit A.

White house on black colorway

1. Flying Geese units.
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4" x 4" black circular square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 4" x 7 1/2" white print rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal black circular corner triangle. Repeat with another 4" x 4" black circular square at the other end of the same white print to complete (1) flying geese unit.

Make (8) black leaf and (13) black bee flying geese units.






2. House units.
Sew (4) 1 1/2" x 2" white print and (3) 1 1/2" x 2" tonal rectangles to make a row.



Add (2) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" white print rectangles to the opposite long sides of sewn unit A.



Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " black print square to the short side of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " tonal rectangle.


Add (1) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" black print rectangle to the right.



Sew (3) 1 1/2" x 2" black print and (2) 1 1/2" x 2" tonal rectangles to make a row unit. Add (1) 2" x 5 1/2" black print rectangle to the bottom. Sew unit to the previously sewn door unit to complete sewn unit B.



Sew units A and B to complete house unit.



Make a total number of house units in the following fabric combinations:

- (10) black bee / white star dot
- (3) black bee / spearmint silver
- (4) black leaf / chartreuse
- (4) black leaf / Tavarua




Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" white print square to the short side of (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" tonal rectangle.


Add (1) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" white print rectangle to the right.



Sew (3) 1 1/2" x 2" white print and (2) 1 1/2" x 2" tonal rectangles to make a row unit. Add (1) 2" x 5 1/2" white print rectangle to the bottom. Sew unit to the previously sewn door unit to complete sewn unit B.



Sew units A and B to complete house unit.



Make a total number of house units in the following fabric combinations:

- (10) white bee / black star dot
- (3) white bee / spearmint silver
- (4) white leaf / chartreuse
- (4) white leaf / Tavarua

3. Matching black print of flying geese units to black print of house units, sew together units to complete house blocks.



Make (10) blocks above

(3) blocks below





3. Matching white print of flying geese units to white print of house units, sew together units to complete house blocks.




Make (10) blocks above

(4) blocks of each below






(3) blocks below



Quilt Top Assembly:

Quilt Top is constructed by sewing pieced columns together. Pieced columns consist of whole and half patch blocks, and house blocks. Refer to quilt diagram below for block placements in constructing pieced columns. The black houses on white colorway might show the placement a little more clearly. Direct substitution is used for the white houses on black colorway. If you are making the white houses on black colorway, all the white skus used are their black counterparts.





Finishing Instructions

- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then top to form quilt sandwich. Baste.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Square up quilt before adding binding strip, hanging sleeve and label.
