# Mountain Pride

Please Read and Follow Instructions Carefully to Ensure a Successful Project!

## Cutting Instructions:

- A. Panel or Theme Fabric (Q4490-141):  
Centering Design, cut 40 1/2" x 22 1/2"
- B. Panel Frame and Binding (1895-537):  
Cut (4) 3" x WOF\*, Subcut (2) 3" x 40 1/2" and (2) 3" x 27 1/2"  
Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF set aside for binding
- C. Mountain Pride Blocks (1895-534 (background), 885-52 (block centers), 1895-168, 885-108 (points):  
Block Centers cut (1) 5 1/2" x WOF, Subcut (3) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"  
Beige Background, Cut (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips, Subcut (24) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares  
Browns, Cut (1) 6" x WOF from EACH Brown, Subcut (6) 6" x 6" squares from EACH  
Cut all 6" x 6" squares in half diagonally
- D. Outer Border (885-294):  
Cut (5) 4" WOF strips



**\*WOF = Width of Fabric Selvage to Selvage**

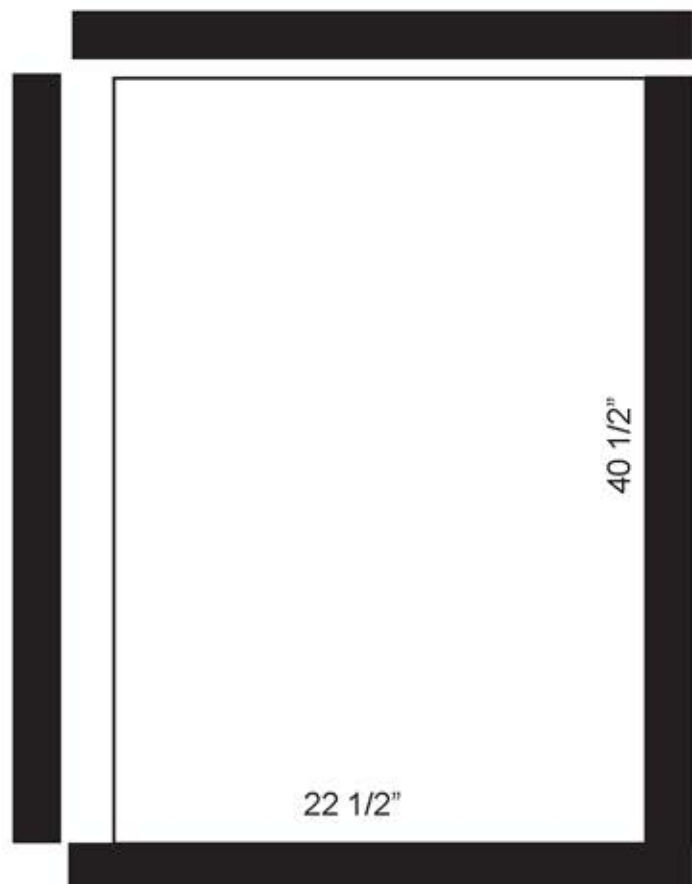
**Note:** All measurements are based on a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

## Piecing Instructions:

### Panel Border:

Using (2) (B) 3" x 40 1/2" Panel Border strips, join to Sides of Panel Fabric. See Diagram 1. Press seams toward Border Strips. Join (2) (B) 3" x 27 1/2" to Top and Bottom of Panel. Panel section will now measure 27 1/2" x 45 1/2".

**Piecing Continued:**  
**Mountain Price Blocks:**

**Star Points:**

Following Diagram 2, below, place a Dark 1 triangle approximately 3/4" from the top and right sides of a Beige 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" square. Stitch 1/4" in from triangle edge. You may trim background fabric or leave on as your template to square the block. Press triangle down. Do not trim excess yet.

NOTE: It is not important to be exact!! In a wonky block inconsistencies are expected!!

Next, following Diagram 3, line up a Dark 2 triangle with the left edge of unit made in Diagram 2. The top of the triangle should be approximately 1/4" down from the top. Stitch 1/4" in from long triangle edge. Again, you may trim background if desired. Press triangle down. If you have left the background fabric intact, you can now turn the block over and trim to 5 1/2" square using the Beige 5 1/2" square as your guide.

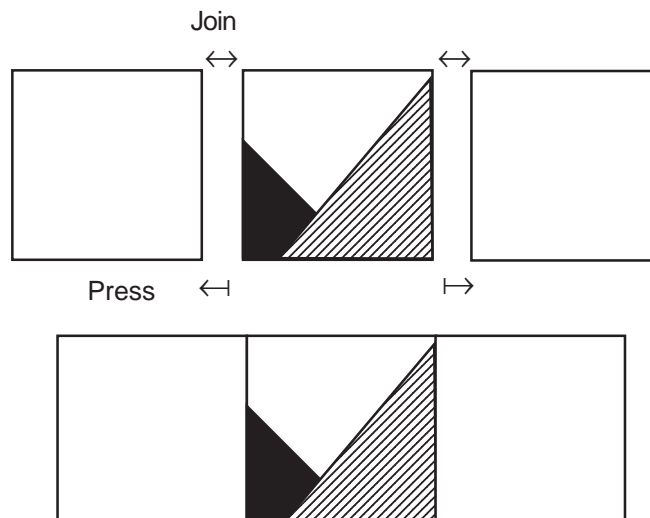
**Diagram 3**



Square will measure  
 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".  
 Make (12).

After (12) squares made in Diagram 3 are complete, construct the rest of your block. Join a Beige 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" on each side of a star point. See Diagram 4, below. Press seams away from Star Points. Unit will measure 5 1/2" x 15 1/2". Make (6).

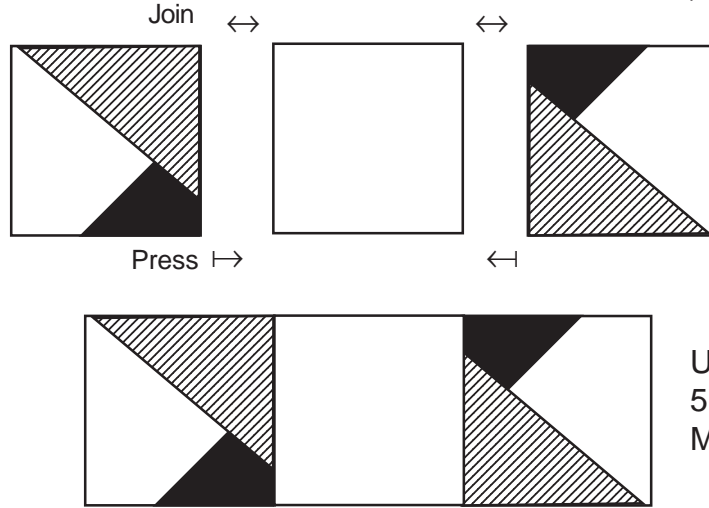

 Make (6).

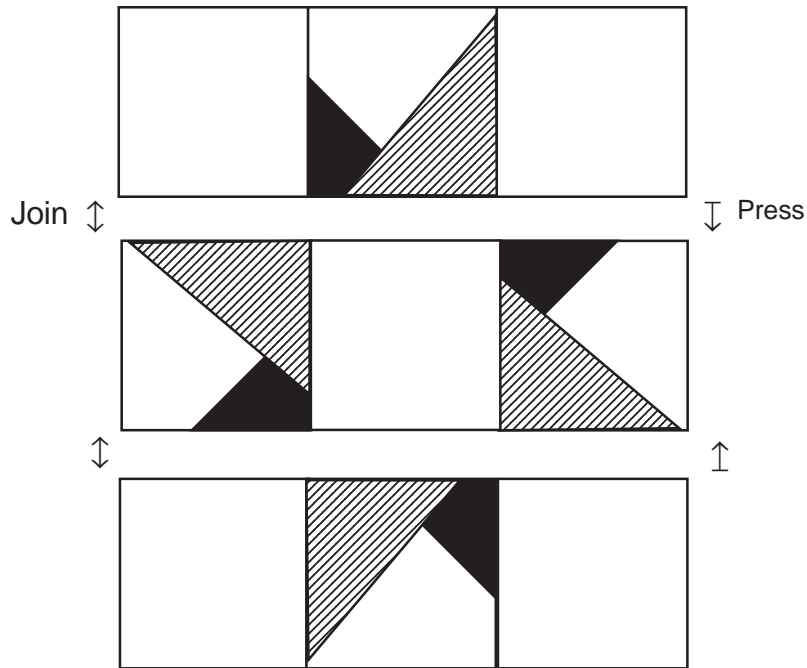
Next, join a Star Point square to each side of a (B)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Square as shown in Diagram 5. Press seams toward Center fabric. Unit will measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make (3).

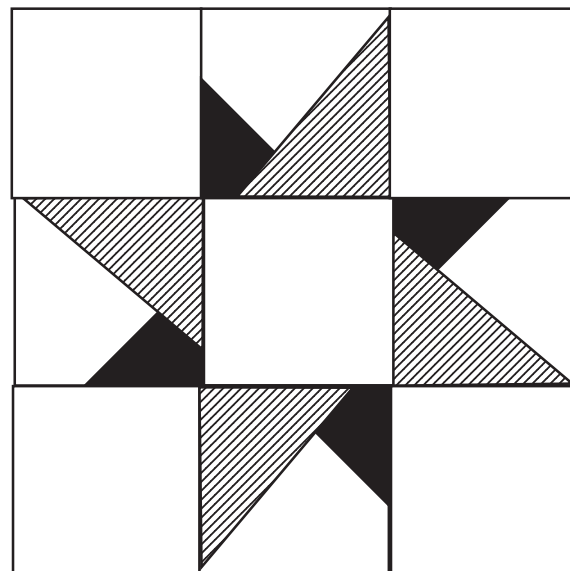


Join units made in Diagrams 4 and 5 to create your Mountain Pride Block. Press seams toward center. Block will measure  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make (3).

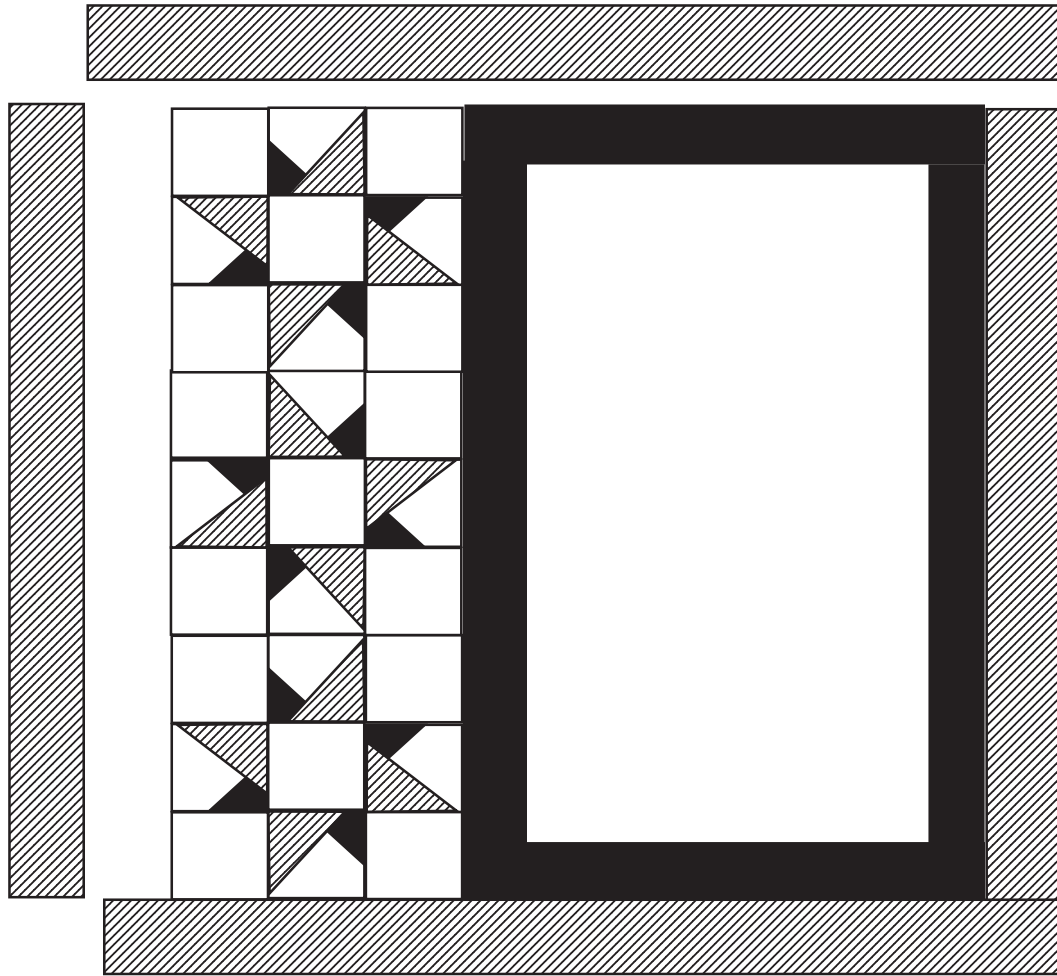
Join (3) Mountain Pride Blocks into a row. Join row to side of Panel Section created in Diagram 1, Pg.1.



Blocks will measure  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ ".  
Make (3).

## Layout Diagram

Following Border instructions, add Outer Borders.



### **Borders:**

To determine the length of the outer side borders, measure quilt through the middle from top to bottom. Using (D) 4" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach border strips to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer border. Next, measure quilt through the middle from side to side to determine the length of the top and bottom outer borders. Using remaining (D) 4" Outer Border strips, join to equal this measurement. Make (2). Attach to the top and bottom of quilt and press seams toward outer border. Quilt will now measure 50.5" x 53.5".

### **Quilting:**

Sandwich quilt top with batting and backing. Baste layers together and quilt as desired to enhance design.

### **Binding:**

Join together (B) 2 1/2" Binding strips and bind using your favorite method.
