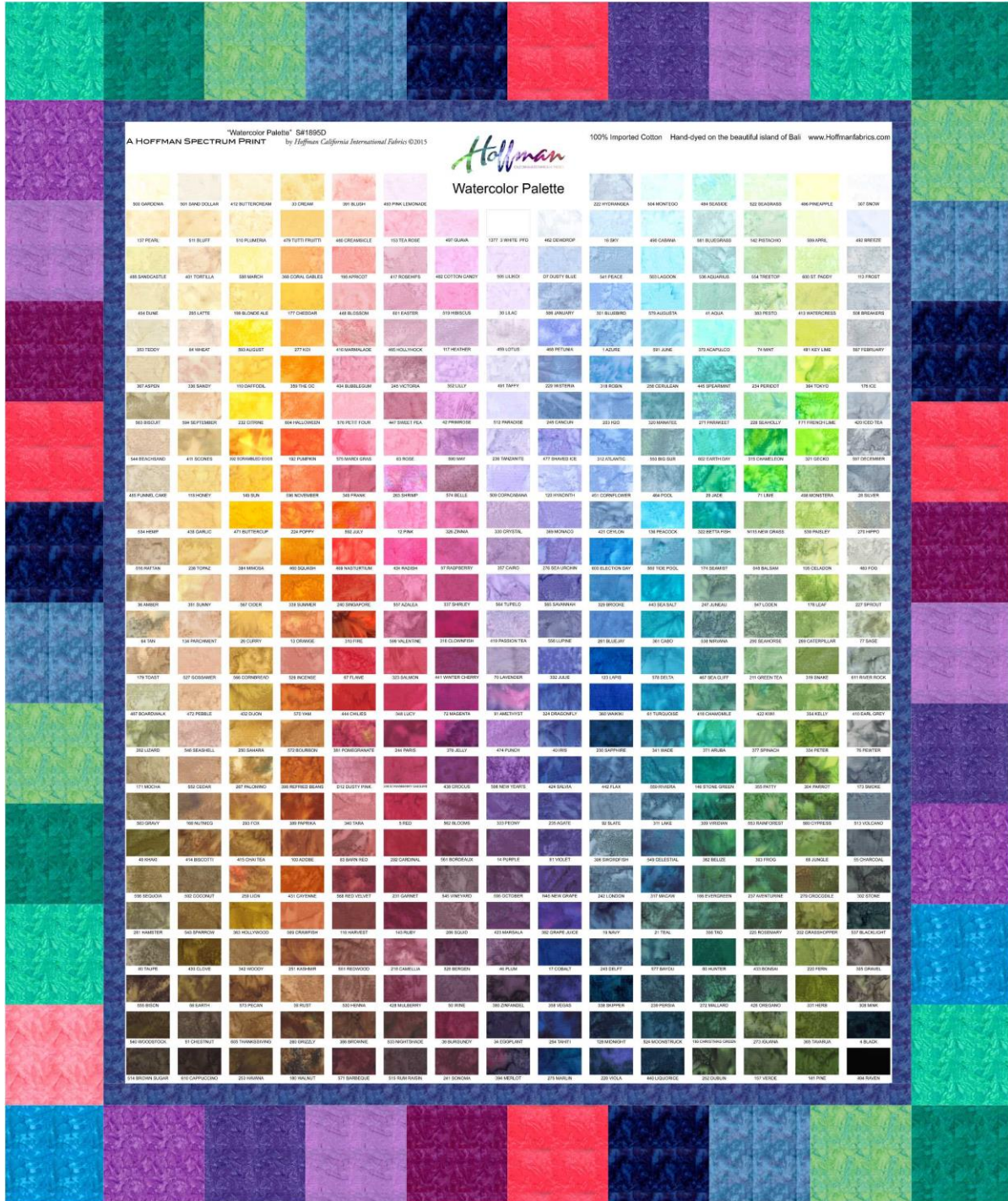

Watercolor Palette

Please Read and Follow Directions With Care To Ensure a Successful Project!

Note: Fabrics were not washed before assembly!!

Fabric Requirements:

One Hoffman Watercolor Palette Digital Panel

2/3 yd Panel Border and Binding

1 Package Gemstone Snaps 5" squares

3 1/2 yds. Backing

Cutting Instructions:

A. Watercolor Palette Digital Panel:

Trim Carefully to 35" x 44 1/2" (selvage may be part of seam allowance)

B. Panel Border:

Cut (3) strips 1 1/2" x Width of Fabric

Cut (2) strips 1 1/4" x 37 1/2"

C. Binding:

Cut (5) 2 1/2" x Width of Fabric

Note: All measurements are based on a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

Piecing Instructions:

Using your (B) 1 1/2" Panel Border strips, join to equal 44 1/2". Make (2). Attach to sides of (A) 35" x 44 1/2" Theme Fabric. Press seams toward border. Next, join (B) 1 1/4" Panel Border strips to top and bottom of Panel. Press seams toward border. Your Center set should now measure 37" x 46".

Piano Key Border:

Make (4) rows of (10) 5" x 5" squares for side borders. (See Quilt Diagram on Pg. 2). Place colors in an order pleasing to you. Your rows should measure 5" x 46". Attach (2) to sides of quilt. Press seams toward Panel Border. Next, join remaining (2) rows to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward Panel Border.

Quilting:

Sandwich your quilt top, batting and backing. Baste layers together and quilt using desired pattern to enhance your quilt top.

Binding:

Join (E) 2 1/2" strips of binding fabric. Bind using your favorite method.
