- For best results, read all directions before beginning.
- I always use a scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (1-2 threads less than $1 / 4$ ") for piecing - such as sewing blocks together and adding borders.
- WOF means width of fabric. LOF means length of fabric. RST means right sides together.
- Label pieces as indicated in the cutting instructions. Piecing instructions will refer to these labels. Cutting instructions include all pieces needed for all blocks. Piecing instructions are for one block. Repeat the piecing instructions for the total number of blocks required.
- To cut squares once on the diagonal, cut square from corner to corner as shown in diagram.



## Cutting~

From strips, cut: <br> $24-47 / 8 "$ squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal. <br> Cut $5-4 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips WOF. From strips, cut: <br> $6-4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, <br> 29-4 $1 / 2$ " squares. <br> Cut $16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips WOF. | Fabric \#2 - Frank <br> 1/4 yard | Cut $2-21 / 2 "$ strips WOF. From strips, cut: $8-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. $16-21 / 2 "$ squares. | $\begin{gathered} \mathbf{H} \\ \mathbf{I} \end{gathered}$ |


| Fabric \#3 - Lucy 3/8 yard | Cut $1-47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip WOF. From strip, cut: <br> $4-47 / 8$ " squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal. <br> Cut $2-21 / 2$ " strips WOF. From strips, cut: <br> $8-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles, <br> $16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. | $\mathrm{J}$ <br> K <br> L |

| Fabric \#4 - Citrine 1/4 yard | Cut $2-21 / 2$ " strips WOF. From strips, cut: $8-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles. $16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. | $\begin{gathered} \mathbf{H} \\ \mathbf{I} \end{gathered}$ |
| Fabric \#5 - Sun 3/8 yard | Cut $1-47 / 8$ " strip WOF. From strip, cut: <br> $4-47 / 8$ squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal. Cut $2-21 / 2$ " strips WOF. From strips, cut: <br> $8-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles, $16-21 / 2$ " squares. | J <br> K <br> L |
| Fabric \#6 - Tokyo 1/8 yard | Cut $1-33 / 8$ " strip WOF. From strip, cut: $12-33 / 8$ " squares. | M |
| Fabric \#7- Parsley $1 / 2 \text { yard }$ | Cut 6-2 $1 / 2$ " strips WOF. From strips, cut: $24-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ " rectangles, $48-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. | $\mathbf{H}$ |


| Fabric \#8 - Cypress <br> $3 / 8$ yard | Cut $2-47 / 8 "$ strips WOF. From strips, cut: <br> $12-47 / 8 "$ squares. Cut squares once on the diagonal. | $\mathbf{J}$ |

## Piecing the maín blocks ~

You will be making blocks in four different colors. Blocks are made exactly the same. The instructions show the blocks using the green fabrics. You will substitute red, yellow or blue fabrics for the green fabrics as indicated to make the three additional colors of blocks.


- Sew $4-\mathbf{N}$ triangles to an $\mathbf{M}$ square as shown. Make 1 - Unit \#1. Unit should measure $41 / 2$ " square. [This instruction uses the same fabrics for all blocks.] Press seams toward $\mathbf{N}$.

- Sew a B triangle to a Cypress J triangle as shown. Make 4 - Unit \#2. Unit should measure $41 / 2$ " square. Press seam toward J. [Substitute Lucy, Sun, or Cobalt J fabrics for the red, yellow or blue blocks.]

- Place a Parsley I square RST on an O rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted line. Trim as indicated by the solid line. Press seam toward I. Make 4 - Unit \#3. Unit should measure $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$. [Substitute Frank, Citrine
 or Lapis I squares for the red, yellow or blue blocks for this step and the next step.]
- Place another Parsley I square RST on the opposite corner of the $\mathbf{O}$ rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted
 line. Trim as indicated by the solid line. Press seam toward I. Make 4 Unit \#4. Unit should measure $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$.
- Place a $\mathbf{G}$ square RST on a Parsley $\mathbf{H}$ rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted line. Trim as indicated by the solid line. Press seam toward
 G. Make 4 - Unit \#5. Unit should measure $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$. [Substitute Frank, Citrine or Lapis $\mathbf{H}$ rectangles for the red, yellow or blue blocks for this step and the next step.]
- Place another $\mathbf{G}$ square RST on the opposite corner of the $\mathbf{H}$ rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted line. Trim
 as indicated by the solid line. Press seam toward G. Make 4 - Unit \#6. Unit should measure $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Sew a Unit \#6 to a Unit \#4 as shown. Make 4 - Unit \#7. Unit should measure $4^{1 / 2}$ " square.

- Arrange 4 of Unit \#7, 4 of Unit \#2 and 1 of Unit \#1 as shown in block diagram on page 4. Sew together in rows. Sew rows together to make block. Block should measure $121 / 2 "$ square.
- Repeat these instructions for a total of 6 - green blocks and 2 each of the red, yellow and blue blocks.


## Piecing the sashing and border units ~

You will be making units in four different colors. Units are made exactly the same. The instructions show the units using the purple fabrics. You will substitute red, yellow and blue fabrics for the purple fabrics as indicated to make the three additional colors of units.


- Place a Sea Urchin $\mathbf{L}$ square RST on an $\mathbf{F}$ rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted line. Trim as indicated by the solid line. Press seam
 toward $\mathbf{L}$. Make 1 - Unit \#8. Unit should measure $21 / 2 " \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ ". [Substitute Lucy, Sun or Cobalt $\mathbf{L}$ squares for the red, yellow or blue blocks for this step and the next step.]
- Place another Sea Urchin $\mathbf{L}$ square RST on the opposite corner of the $\mathbf{F}$ rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted line. Trim as indicated by the solid line. Press seam toward $\mathbf{L}$. Make 1 -
 Unit \#9. Unit should measure $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2$ ".
- Place a $\mathbf{G}$ square RST on a Sea Urchin $\mathbf{K}$ rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted line. Trim as indicated by the solid line. Press seam
 toward G. Make 1 - Unit \#10. Unit should measure $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$. [Substitute Lucy, Sun or Cobalt $\mathbf{K}$ rectangles for the red, yellow or blue blocks for this step and the next step.]
- Place another $\mathbf{G}$ square RST on the opposite corner of the $\mathbf{K}$ rectangle as shown. Sew from corner to corner as indicated by the dotted line. Trim
 as indicated by the solid line. Press seam toward G. Make 1 - Unit \#11. Unit should measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Sew a Unit \#11 to a Unit \#9 as shown to make sashing or border Unit \#12. Unit should measure $41 / 2$ " square.

- Repeat these instructions for a total of 14 - purple units and 8 each of red, yellow and blue units.


## Piecing the sashing ~

- Sew an $\mathbf{E}$ square to opposite sides of a red Unit \#12 as shown to make red Sashing block. Sashing block should measure $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$.

- Repeat these instructions for a total of 4 - red blocks and 2 each yellow and blue blocks.

- Sew 2 - E squares, $2-\mathbf{C}$ rectangles, and 1 each of a red, yellow and blue Unit \#12 as shown. Make 1 of Sashing Row 1 and 2 of Sashing Row 2. Sashing pieces should measure $41 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$.


Sashing Row 1 - Top sashing row in quilt diagram on page 9.


## Sashing Row 2 - Middle sashing row and bottom sashing row in quilt diagram on page 9.

- Arrange main blocks and sashing pieces as shown in center of quilt diagram on page 9 (outlined in black). Sew together in rows. Sew rows together.


## Piecing the border~

- Sew an E square to a purple Unit \#12 as shown. Make 7 - Unit \#13. Unit should measure $41 / 2 " \times 81 / 2$ ".

- Sew a purple Unit \#12 to a red Unit \#12. Make 1 - Unit \#14. Unit should measure $41 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2$ ".

- Sew a purple Unit \#12 to a yellow Unit \#12. Make 3 - Unit \#15. Unit should measure $41 / 2 " \times 81 / 2$ ".

- Sew a purple Unit \#12 to a blue Unit \#12. Make 3 - Unit \#16. Unit should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

- Arrange 2 of Unit \#13, 1 of Unit \#15, 1 of Unit \#16, 2 - D rectangles and 3-A rectangles as shown. Sew together. Row should measure $81 / 2$ " $\times 60^{1 / 2 "}$. Sew to left side of quilt center as shown in quilt diagram on page 9 .

- Arrange 2 of Unit \#13, 1 of Unit \#15, 1 of Unit \#16, 2 - D rectangles and 3-A rectangles as shown. Sew together. Row should measure $81 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$. Sew to right side of quilt center as shown in quilt diagram on page 9 .

- Arrange 2 of Unit \#13, 1 of Unit \#14 and 4 - A rectangles as shown. Sew together. Row should measure $81 / 2 " \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew to top of quilt center as shown in quilt diagram on page 9 .

- Arrange 1 of Unit \#13, 1 of Unit \#15, 1 of Unit \#16 and 4 - A rectangles as shown. Sew together. Row should measure $81 / 2$ " $\times 601 / 2$ ". Sew to bottom of quilt center as shown in quilt diagram on page 9 .



## Putting it all together ~

- Sew the short ends of the $21 / 2$ " Fabric \#1 strips together. Measure the length of your quilt center and cut 2 border pieces to that measurement. Sew to the long sides of the quilt center.
- Measure the width of your quilt center and cut 2 border pieces to this measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.


## Layer, quilt, bind and enjoy!
