

Sub-cut (180) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. Row 3 (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. Row 3 (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares and (12) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles. (1) 2 ½" x 3 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 3 ½" squares. (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles and (12) 2 ¾" x 3 ¾" squares. (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 5 ¼" and (12) 1" x 5 ¼" rectangles. Row 4 patch blocks & O block (1) 10 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 10 ½" x 10 ½" squares (for patch blocks). From remainder, cut for O block: (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½" and (4) 1" x 1" squares. (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½", (2) 1 ½" x 3 1/2" and (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 10 ½" x 10 ½" squares (for patch blocks). From remainder, cut for O block: (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½" and (4) 1" x 1" squares. (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½", (2) 1 ½" x 3 1/2" and (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" x 3 1/2" and (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" x 3 1/2" and (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 10 ½" x 4 ½" and (2) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares. (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½", (2) 1 ½" x 2 ½" and (2) 1 ½" x 3 rectangles.

	Row 5 (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" x 5 ½", (1) 3" x 7 ½", (1) 3" x 10 ½" and (4) 1 ½" x 3" rectangles.

Constructing Row 1 & Row 7

1. Sew together (1) 1 ½" x WOF **Background** strip and (1) 1 ½" x WOF **Fabric A** strip, along the long sides to make a strip set. Make a total of (3) strip sets, and sub-cut at 1 ½" intervals for a total of (64) units, 8 for each block.

Sew together (2) units to make a 4-patch unit. Make a total of (4) units.




2. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Background** rectangle to the left of step 1 unit, followed by (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Background** rectangle to the bottom of the same unit.




- 3. Sew together (1) 1 1 /2" x WOF **Background** strip and (1) 3 1 /2" x WOF green strip, along the long sides to make a strip set. Make a total of (4) strip sets and sub-cut at 1 1 /2" intervals for a total of (96) units, (12) for each block.
- 4. Sew (1) $1^{-1/2}$ " x $3^{-1/2}$ " green rectangle to the left of step 2 unit, followed by (1) step 3 to the bottom of the same unit.




5. Sew (1) step 3 unit to the left of step 4 unit.




Then sew (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Background squares to the opposite short sides of (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " green rectangle to make a row unit.



Sew row unit to the bottom of step 4 unit.




6. Sew (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangle to the top of (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 3 $^{1}/_{2}$ " green rectangle to make a column unit. Sew unit to the left of step 5 unit.



Then sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Background rectangle to the left side of (1) step 3 unit to make a row unit, as shown.

Sew row unit to the bottom of step 5 unit to complete 1 block quadrant. Quadrant measures $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make a total of (2) quadrants, and (2) mirror-imaged quadrants




7. Sew (1) quadrant and (1) mirror-imaged quadrant to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 6 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangle to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.

Sew (2) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 6 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric A square to make a row unit.


Sew together row units to complete block center.



8. Sew (2) 1 1 /2" x 13 1 /2" Background rectangles to the opposite sides of block center, followed by (2) 1 1 /2" x 15 1 /2" Background rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of block center to complete (1) block. Block measures 15 1 /2" x 15 1 /2" unfinished.



Make a total of (2) blocks each for the following green fabrics:



9. Arrange and sew (4) blocks to make Row 1, and Row 7. Row 1 $\,$

Constructing Row 2 & Row 6

1. Sew together (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric squares and (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Background square to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.




Sew together (2) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Background squares and (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" fabric square to make a row unit.




Sew together row units to make (1) 9 patch block. Block measures 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

2. Sew together (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Background squares and (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric square to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.






Sew together row units to make (1) 9 patch block. Block measures 3 ½" x 3 ½" unfinished.

3. Arrange and sew together (20) blocks to make a pieced row, alternating blocks made in step 1 and 2. Make a total of (2) rows for Row 2 and Row 6.



Constructing Row 3

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" red1 square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3" x 5 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $^{1}/_{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another red1 square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle to make a Flying Geese unit. Sew (2) 3" x 3" Background squares to the opposite short sides of Flying Geese unit.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3" x $10^{-1}/2$ " red1 rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $^{1}/4$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 3" x 3" Background square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle.




3. Sew (2) 2 ³/₄" x 3" Background rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x 3" green rectangle to make a row unit.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" red 2 square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of the previously sewn unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 3" x 3" red2 square at the top right corner of the same sewn unit.

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" Background square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" red2 square. Sew ¼" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45-degree line on quilting ruler, trim units to measure 3" x 3" unfinished. Add HST units to the opposite short sides of step 3 unit.



5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2^{1/2}$ " x $2^{1/2}$ " Background square. Place square, right sides together, at the top right corner of (1) $2^{1/2}$ " x $3^{1/2}$ " green rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1 /4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (1) $1^{1/2}$ " x $1^{1/2}$ " Background square at the bottom left corner of the same rectangle.




6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " green square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $^{1}/_{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Sew (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background square to the top of sewn unit.



- 7. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 3 1/2" Background rectangle to the left, and step 5 unit to the right of step 6 unit.
- Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 1/4" Background rectangle to the top, and (1) 1" x 5 1/4" Background rectangle to the bottom of the previously sewn unit.

Repeat to make a mirror-imaged unit. Sew both units to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x 5" green


rectangle.



8. Sew together units made steps 1, 2, 4 and 7 to complete (1) block. Block measures 10 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 12 $^{1}/_{2}$ " unfinished.



Make a total of (2) blocks for the following red1 / red2 / green fabric combinations:



9. Arrange and sew together blocks into a pieced row.



Constructing Row 4

(All blocks will measure 10 ½" x 10 ½" unfinished)

1. N block

a. Sew (2) 1 3 /4" x 3" Fabric K rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x 3" Fabric A rectangle. Then, add to (2) 1" x 3" Background rectangles to the left and right sides to make a row unit.



b. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of

(1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of

(1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric A square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle to make a Flying Geese unit. Add (2) 1 ½" x 1 ½" Background squares to the opposite short ends of Flying Geese unit. Add to the top of step a unit.



c. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Background square. Place square, right sides together, at the top right corner of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" Fabric F rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Background square at the bottom left corner of the same rectangle.



d. Sew step c unit on top of step b unit. Add (2) 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 10 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric F rectangles to the left and right sides, followed by (2) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 10 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangles to the left and right sides to

complete N block.



2. O block

a. Sew (2) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric E rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x 2 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1" x 1" Background square. Place square, right sides together, at the corner of sewn unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional 1" x 1" Background squares at the remaining (3) corners of sewn unit.

b. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" Background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle.



Repeat to make a mirror-imaged unit and sew both units to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle.

c. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Background rectangle to the bottom step b unit, followed by (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Background rectangles to the left and right sides.



d. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of step c unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J squares at the remaining corners of the same unit.

e. Sew (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric J rectangles to the left and right sides of step d unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric J rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with second 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Background square at opposite end of Fabric J rectangle. Sew to bottom of step d unit.



f. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric J square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric K square. Sew ¼" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) HST unit. Place HST unit, right sides together with contrasting fabrics facing each other, on another HST unit. Sew ¼" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) QST units. Block uses only (1) unit. Open and press. Trim unit to measure 2 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.

g. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2^{1/2}$ " x $2^{1/2}$ " Background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $2^{1/2}$ " x $4^{1/2}$ " Fabric J rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat to make a mirror-imaged unit and sew both units to the opposite sides of step f unit.



h. Sew step g unit on to of step e unit to complete O block.




3. E block

a. Sew (1) 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 4 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric H rectangle to the left of (1) 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background square to make a row unit.



b. Sew (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Background rectangles to the top and bottom of step a unit, followed by (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H rectangles.



c. Add (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric H rectangle to the left of step b unit, followed by (2) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Background rectangles to the left and right sides to complete E block.



4. L block


a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $^{1}/_{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric A square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle. Sew (2) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 3 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangles to the opposite sides of sewn unit.



b. Sew (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Add (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" Background rectangles to the left and right sides of sewn unit.



c. Sew (2) 2 $^{3}/_{4}$ " x 3 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric G rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1" x 3 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Add (2) 2" x 3 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangles to the left and right sides of sewn unit.



d. Sew together units made in steps a-c. Add (1) 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 8 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background rectangle to the top, followed by (1) 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 8 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric B rectangle to the left, and (1) 2 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 10 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric B rectangle

to the bottom to complete L block.



5. Sew together N, O, E, L blocks to make a row unit. Add (2) 10 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 10 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background squares to the opposite short sides to complete Row 4.



Constructing Row 5


1. 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3" x 5 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric 1 rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $^{1}/_{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 3" x 3" Background square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle. Add (2) 3" x 3" Background squares to the opposite short sides.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3" x 7 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Fabric 2 rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $^{1}/_{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 3" x 3" Background square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle. Add (2) 2" x 3" Background squares to the opposite short sides.



3. Sew together (5) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" Fabric 3 and (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" Fabric 4 rectangles along the long sides to make a rectangle unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of the rectangle unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 3" x 3" Background square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle unit. Add (2)1" x 3" Background squares to the opposite short sides.



4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of

(1) 3" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 1 rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 3" x 3" Background square at the opposite corner of the same rectangle.




5. Sew (2) 3" x 5" Background rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) 1 ½" x 3" Fabric B rectangle.



6. Sew together units made in steps 1-5 to complete (1) block. Block measures 10 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 13" unfinished.



7. Make (1) block each for the following Fabric 1 / Fabric 2 / Fabric 3 / Fabric 4 combinations.



8. Sew together blocks to make Row 5.



Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew together pieced rows and (4) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 60 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Background sashing strips to complete quilt top in the following order:

Row 1, Row 2, sashing strip, Row 3, sashing strip, Row 4, sashing strip, Row 5, sashing strip, Row 6, and Row 7.



Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to complete the quilt.
