The construction of each block and the overall quilt assembly are detailed in these instructions. Cutting instructions are based upon width of fabric (WOF) strips. WOF is assumed to be 43-inches with selvedge removed. Assembly assumes scant ¼-inch seams and right sides together (RST).

NOTE: Starching and pressing fabric before cutting will minimize warping during

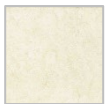
To make freezer paper templates, cut three pieces of freezer paper larger than the template to be made. Layer the three pages shiny side down. Using a hot, dry iron, press three pages together to make freezer paper sandwich. Trace template onto sandwich and cut to shape. Make one of each.

To use freezer paper templates, set template shiny side down on right side of fabric. Using a hot, dry iron, fuse template to fabric. Let template cool. Cut fabric around template. Then, peel template from fabric. Template can be reused multiple times.

For strips labeled [FUSED], apply fusible of your choice to the back of the fabric in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Most manufacturers recommend using a hot, dry iron.

Note: This pattern uses raw edge applique only. If you want finished edge, add seam allowance to pieces.

Cutting Instructions:



1895-265 Oyster:

- **Cut** four 3-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** two 3-inch x 26-inch Strips and two 3-inch x 31-inch Strips. **(Border 1)**
- **Cut** two 7 ½-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** eight 7 ½-inch Squares. **Subcut** each Square once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make sixteen 7 ½-inch Triangles. **(Setting Triangles)**
- **Cut** one 4 ¼-inch x WOF Strip.
 - **Subcut** two 4 ¼-inch Squares. **(QST – Raspberry Inner)**
 - **Subcut** two 3 ½-inch Squares. **(QST – Raspberry Outer)**
- **Cut** six 2 ¾-inch x WOF Strips.
 - **Subcut** twelve 2 ¾-inch Squares. **Subcut** Squares once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make twenty-four 2 ¾-inch Triangles. **(Diamond in Square – Raspberry Center and Diamond in Square – Raspberry Inner)**
 - **Subcut** sixty-four 2 ¾-inch Squares. **(HST – Raspberry Border and HST - Briar)**
- **Cut** four 2-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** seventy-two 2-inch Squares. **Subcut** Squares once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make one hundred forty-four Triangles. **(Diamond in Square - Raspberry Outer and Diamond in Square Raspberry Border)**
- **Cut** two 2 ¼-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** thirty-two 2 ¼-inch Squares. **(House - Briar)**



1895-531 Papyrus:

- **Cut** one 3-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** two 3-inch Squares. **(HST – Raspberry Outer)**
- **Cut** four 3 1/8-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** two 3 1/8-inch x 32-inch Strips and two 3 1/8-inch x 37 ¼-inch Strips. **(Border 3)**
- **Cut** five 3-inch x WOF Strips. Sew Strips together end to end. **Subcut** two 3-inch x 47 ¾-inch Strips and two 3-inch x 52 ¾-inch Strips. **(Border 5)**
- **Cut** three 2 ¾-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** thirty-two 2 ¾-inch Squares. **(HST – Briar)**
- **Cut** two 2 ¼-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** thirty-two 2 ¼-inch Squares. **(House - Briar)**



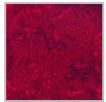
1895-533 Nightshade:

- **Cut** one 4-inch x WOF Strip.
 - **Subcut** two 4-inch Squares. **Subcut** Squares once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make four 4-inch Triangles. (**Raspberry Inner**)
 - **Subcut** eight **Piece C** using Template C. (**Motif**) [FUSED]
 - **Subcut** eight **Piece F** using Template F. (**Motif**) [FUSED]
- **Cut** one 1 ¾-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** sixteen 1 ¾-inch Square. (**Diamond in Square – Briar**)
- **Cut** four 1-inch x WOF Strips. Sew **Subcut** two 1-inch x 31-inch Strips and two 1-inch x 32-inch Strips. (**Border 2**)



1895-60 Hunter:

- **Cut** four 2-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** seventy-two 2-inch Squares. **Subcut** Squares once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make one hundred forty-four Triangles. (**Diamond in Square - Raspberry Outer** and **Diamond in Square Raspberry Border**)
- **Cut** one 2 ¾-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** eight 2 ¾-inch Squares. **Subcut** Squares once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make sixteen 2 ¾-inch Triangles. (**Diamond in Square - Raspberry Inner**)



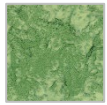
1895-231 Garnet:

- **Cut** one 3 ½-inch x WOF Strip.
 - **Subcut** one 3 ½-inch Square. (**HST – Raspberry Center**)
 - **Subcut** two 3-inch Squares. **Subcut** Squares once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make four 3-inch Triangles. (**HST – Raspberry Outer**)
 - **Subcut** thirty-two **Piece F** using Template F. (**Motif**) [FUSED]
- **Cut** one 2 ¼-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** sixteen 2 ¼-inch Squares. (**HST – Raspberry Border**)



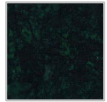
1895-292 Cardinal:

- **Cut** one 4 ¼-inch x WOF Strips.
 - **Subcut** two 4 ¼-inch Squares. (**QST – Raspberry Inner**)
 - **Subcut** four 4-inch Squares. (**HST – Raspberry Inner** and **HST – Raspberry Center**)
 - **Subcut** two 3 ½-inch Squares. (**QST – Raspberry Outer**)
 - **Subcut** two 3-inch Squares. (**HST – Raspberry Outer**)
- **Cut** three 2 ¾-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** thirty-two 2 ¾-inch Squares. (**HST – Raspberry Border**)
- **Cut** one 1 ½-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** eight **Piece D** and eight **Piece E**, using Template D and Template E, respectively. (**Motif**) [FUSED]
- **Cut** one 1-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** forty **Piece F** using **Piece F**. (**Motif**) [FUSED]



1895-269 Caterpillar:

- **Cut** one 2 5/8-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** twelve 2 5/8-inch Squares. (**Diamond in Square – Raspberry Center** and **Diamond in Square – Raspberry Inner**)
- **Cut** one 2-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** eight 2-inch Squares. (**Diamond in Square – Raspberry Outer**)
- **Cut** three 1 3/4-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** sixty-four 1 3/4-inch Squares. (**Diamond in Square – Raspberry Border**)
- **Cut** two 1-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** forty-eight **Piece F** using Template F. (**Motif**) [FUSED]



1895-31 Emerald:

- **Cut** one 2 3/4-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** four 2 3/4-inch Squares. **Subcut** Squares once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make eight 2 3/4-inch Triangles. (**Diamond in Square – Raspberry Center**)
- **Cut** five 1 3/8-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** one hundred twenty-eight 1 3/8-inch Squares. (**House – Briar**)



1895-137 Pearl:

- **Cut** two 2-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** thirty-two 2-inch Squares. **Subcut** each Square once diagonally, from corner to corner, to make sixty-four 2-inch Triangles. (**Diamond in Square – Briar**)



1895-141 Pine:

- **Cut** two 2-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** thirty-two **Piece B** using Template B. (**Motif**)
- **Cut** one 1-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** eight **Piece A** and sixteen **Piece F** using Template A and Template F. (**Motif**) [FUSED]
- **Cut** six 2 1/2-inch x WOF Strips. (**Binding**)



1895-433 Bonsai:

- **Cut** two 1-inch x WOF Strip. **Subcut** fifty-six **Piece F** using Template F. (**Motif**) [FUSED]



1895-563 Biscuit:

- **Cut** one 4-inch x WOF Strips. **Subcut** four 4-inch Squares. (**HST – Raspberry Center** and **HST – Raspberry Inner**)



Raspberry Center Block

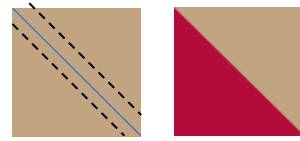


Figure 1 Half Square Triangle

1. Make four **Half Square Triangles (HST)**. (Figure 1)
 - a. Draw diagonal line, from corner to corner, on back of two Biscuit 4-inch Squares.
 - b. Place Biscuit 4-inch Square and Cardinal 4-inch Square RST.
 - c. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch seam on both sides of drawn line.
 - d. Cut on drawn line and press toward Cardinal to make two **HST**.
 - e. Press and trim to $3\frac{1}{2}$ -inch square.

2. Make four **Diamond in Square**. (Figure 2)
 - a. Sew Emerald $2\frac{3}{4}$ -inch Triangle to one side of Caterpillar $2\frac{5}{8}$ -inch Square. Press toward Caterpillar.
 - b. Sew Oyster $2\frac{3}{4}$ -inch Triangle to opposite side of Caterpillar $2\frac{5}{8}$ -inch Square. Press toward Caterpillar.
 - c. Sew Emerald $2\frac{3}{4}$ -inch Triangle to third side of Caterpillar $2\frac{5}{8}$ -inch Square. Press toward Emerald.
 - d. Sew Oyster $2\frac{3}{4}$ -inch Triangle to last side of Caterpillar $2\frac{5}{8}$ -inch Square. Press toward Oyster.
 - e. Trim **Diamond in Square** to $3\frac{1}{2}$ -inch square.

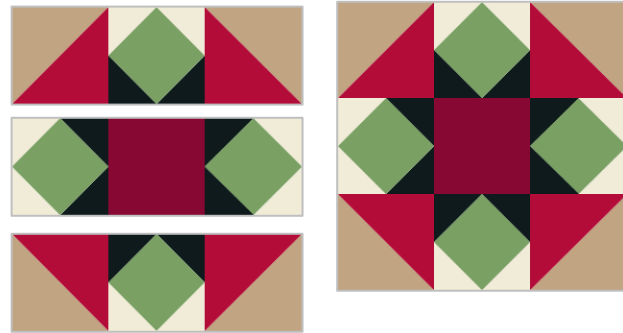


Figure 3 Raspberry Center

3. Assemble **Raspberry Center**. (Figure 3)
 - a. Make two **Outer Row**. Sew **HST** to both sides of **Diamond in Square**. Note orientation. Press seam toward HST.
 - b. Make one **Inner Row**. Sew **Diamond in Square** to both sides of Garnet $3\frac{1}{2}$ -inch Square. Note orientation. Press seam toward Garnet.
 - c. Sew **Outer Rows** to both sides of **Inner Row** to complete Raspberry Center, which should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ -inch square.

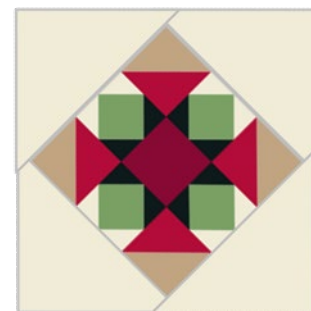


Figure 4 Framed Raspberry Center Block

4. Frame **Raspberry Center Block**. (Figure 4)
 - a. Sew Oyster $7\frac{1}{2}$ -inch Triangles to opposite sides of **Raspberry Center**. Press seams toward Oyster.
 - b. Sew Oyster $7\frac{1}{2}$ -inch Triangles to other two sides of **Raspberry Center**. Press seams toward Oyster.
 - c. Trim **Raspberry Center Block** to $13\frac{1}{4}$ -inch square.

Raspberry Inner Blocks

- Using method from Step 1, make four **HST** with two Biscuit 4-inch Squares and two Cardinal 4-inch Squares. Press and trim to 3 ½-inch. (Figure 5)

- Using method from Step 2, make eight **Diamond in Square** with eight Caterpillar 2 5/8-inch Squares, sixteen Oyster 2 ¾-inch Triangles, and sixteen Hunter 2 ¾-inch Triangles. Press and trim to 3 ½-inch. (Figure 6)

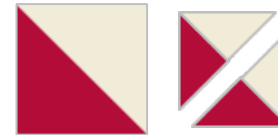


Figure 7 Half HST

- Using method from Step 1, make four **HST** with two Oyster 4 ¼-inch Squares and two Cardinal 4 ¼-inch Squares. Draw one line perpendicular to **HST** seam. Cut on line to make four sets of **Half HST**. Press and trim short sides to 3 ½-inch. (Figure 7)

- Assemble four **Raspberry Rectangles**. (Figure 8 and 9)

- Make four **Top Row**. Sew **HST** to left side of **Diamond in Square**. Sew **Half HST** to right side of **Diamond in Square**. Note orientation. Press seam away from **Diamond in Square**.

- Make four **Middle Rows**. Sew **Diamond in Square** to left side of Nightshade 4-inch Triangle. Note orientation. Press seam toward Nightshade.



- Sew **Middle Row** to bottom of **Top Row**. Then, sew **Half HST** to bottom of **Middle Row** to complete **Raspberry Inner Block**, which should measure 9 7/8-inch on short sides.

- Sew Oyster 7 ½-inch Triangles to both short sides of Raspberry Inner Block to make **Raspberry Rectangles**. Make four **Raspberry Rectangles**, which measure 13 ¼-inch x 6 7/8-inch.

Raspberry Outer Blocks

- Using method from Step 1, make four **HST** with two Papyrus 3-inch Squares and two Cardinal 3-inch Squares. Press and trim to 2 ½-inch. (Figure 10)

- Using method from Step 2, make eight **Diamond in Square** with eight Caterpillar 2-inch Squares, sixteen Oyster 2-inch Triangles, and sixteen Hunter 2-inch Triangles. Press and trim to 2 ½-inch. (Figure 11)

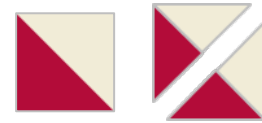


Figure 12 Half HST

11. Using method from Step 7, make four **Half HST sets** with two Oyster 3 ½-inch Squares and two Cardinal 3 ½-inch Squares. Press and trim short sides to 2 ½-inch. (Figure 12)

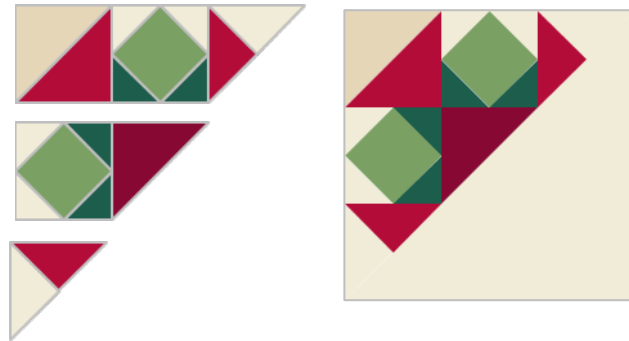


Figure 13 Raspberry Outer Block

12. Assemble four **Raspberry Outer Blocks**. (Figure 13)

- a. Make four **Top Row**. Sew **HST** to left side of **Diamond in Square**. Sew **Half HST** to right side of **Diamond in Square**. Note orientation. Press seam away from **Diamond in Square**.
- b. Make four **Middle Rows**. Sew **Diamond in Square** to left side of Garnet 3-inch Triangle. Note orientation. Press seam toward Garnet.
- c. Sew **Middle Row** to bottom of **Top Row**. Then, sew **Half HST** to bottom of **Middle Row** to complete **Raspberry Triangle**, which should measure 7 ¼-inch on short sides.
- d. Sew Oyster 7 ½-inch Triangle to **Raspberry Triangle**. Press seam toward Oyster.
- e. Trim **Raspberry Outer Block** to 6 7/8-inch.

Raspberry & Hearts Motifs

13. Place Raspberry & Hearts Layout under corners of Raspberry Center Block and Raspberry Outer Blocks. Align line of Layout with seams. Make eight Motifs.

14. Aligning pieces with the template, place pieces on Oyster in the following order (Figure 14):

- a. Pine **Piece A**
- b. Pine **Piece B**
- c. Nightshade **Piece C**
- d. Cardinal **Piece D** and Cardinal **Piece E**
- e. Pine **Piece F**
- f. Bonsai **Piece F**
- g. Caterpillar **Piece F**
- h. Cardinal **Piece F**
- i. Garnet **Piece F**
- j. Nightshade **Piece F**

15. Using hot, dry iron, fuse pieces in place. Once cool, carefully peel pieces from mat. Make eight Raspberry & Heart Motifs.



16. Using coordinating thread, secure Raspberry & Heart Motifs with Blanket or other decorative stitch. Keep stitch length small.

Raspberry Border Blocks

17. Using method from Step 1, make sixty-four **HST** with thirty-two Oyster 2 ¾-inch Squares and thirty-two Cardinal 2 ¾-inch Squares. Press and trim to 2 ¾-inch. (Figure 15)

18. Using method from Step 2, make sixty-four **Diamond in Square** with sixty-four Caterpillar 1 ¾-inch Squares, one hundred twenty-eight (128) Oyster 2-inch Triangles, and one hundred twenty-eight (128) Hunter 2-inch Triangles. Press and trim to 2 ¾-inch. (Figure 16)

19. Assemble **Raspberry Border Blocks**. (Figure 17)

- a. Make thirty-two **Outer Rows**. Sew **HST** to both sides of **Diamond in Square**. Note orientation. Press seam toward HST.
- b. Make sixteen **Inner Rows**. Sew **Diamond in Square** to both sides of Garnet 2 ¾-inch Square. Note orientation. Press seam toward Cardinal.
- c. Sew **Outer Rows** to both sides of **Inner Row** to complete Raspberry Center, which should measure 5 ¾-inch square.

Briar Blocks

20. Using method from Step 1, make sixty-four **HST** with thirty-two Oyster 2 ¾-inch Squares and thirty-two Papyrus 2 ¾-inch Squares. Press and trim to 2 ¾-inch square. (Figure 18)

21. Using method from Step 2, make sixteen **Diamond in Square** with sixty-four Pearl 2-inch Triangle and sixteen Nightshade 1 ¾-inch Squares. Press and trim to 2 ¾-inch. (Figure 19)

22. Make thirty-two Oyster **Houses**. (Figure 20)

- a. Draw one diagonal line on back of sixty-four Emerald 1 3/8-inch Squares. (orange line)
- b. Align Emerald 1 3/8-inch Square with corner of Oyster 2 ¼-inch Square.
- c. Sew on drawn line. Then, trim ¼-inch from seam. (green line)
- d. Press open to make a square.
- e. Align Emerald 1 3/8-inch Square with adjacent corner of Oyster 2 ¼-inch Square.
- f. Sew on drawn line. Then, trim ¼-inch from seam.
- g. Press open to make square. Trim to 2 ¼-inch square.

23. Using method from Step 22, make thirty-two Papyrus **Houses**, with sixty-four Emerald 1 3/8-inch Squares and thirty-two Papyrus 2 1/4-inch Square. (Figure 21)

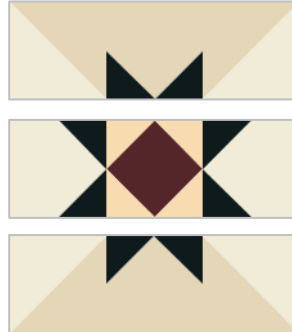
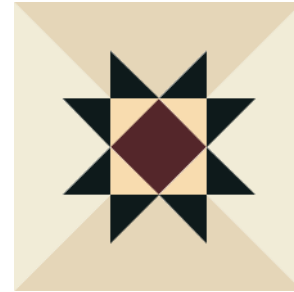


Figure 22 Briar Block

24. Assemble **Briar Blocks**. (Figure 22)

- Make thirty-two **Outer Rows**. Sew **HST** to both sides of **Papyrus House**. Note orientation. Press seam toward HST.
- Make sixteen **Inner Rows**. Sew **Oyster House** to both sides of **Diamond in Square**. Note orientation. Press seam toward **Diamond in Square**.
- Sew **Outer Rows** to both sides of **Inner Row** to complete **Briar**, which should measure 5 3/4-inch square.

Quilt Assembly


25. Assemble **Quilt Center**. (Figure 23)
- Make two **Outer Rows**. Sew **Raspberry Outer Block** to both sides of **Raspberry Rectangle**. Note orientation. **Outer Rows** should measure 26-inch x 6 7/8-inch.
 - Make one **Inner Row**. Sew **Raspberry Rectangles** to both sides of Raspberry Center. Note orientation. **Inner Rows** should measure 26-inch x 13 1/4-inch.
 - Sew **Outer Rows** to both sides of **Inner Rows** to complete **Quilt Center**.
 - Press **Quilt Center**, which should measure 26-inch square.

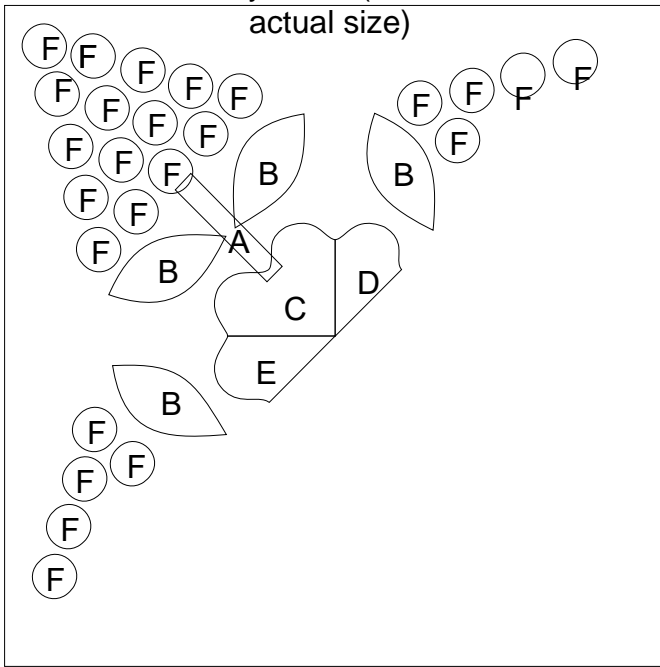
26. Add **Oyster Border 1**. Sew Oyster 3-inch x 26-inch Strips to left side and right side of **Quilt Center**. Then, sew Oyster 3-inch x 31-inch Strips to top and bottom of **Quilt Center**.
27. Add **Nightshade Border 2**. Sew Nightshade 1-inch x 31-inch Strips to left side and right side of **Quilt Center**. Then, sew Nightshade 1-inch x 32-inch Strips to top and bottom of **Quilt Center**.
28. Add **Papyrus Border 3**. Sew Papyrus 3 1/8-inch x 32-inch Strips to left side and right side of **Quilt Center**. Then, sew Papyrus 3 1/8-inch x 37 1/4-inch Strips to top and bottom of **Quilt Center**.
29. Add **Pieced Border 4**.
- Make four **Pieced Borders**. Sew together four **Briar Blocks** and three **Raspberry Border Blocks**, alternating, starting with **Briar Blocks**. **Pieced Borders** should measure 5 3/4-inch x 37 1/4-inch.
 - Sew **Pieced Borders** to right side and left side of **Quilt Center**.



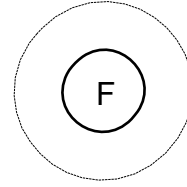
- c. Sew **Raspberry Border Blocks** to opposite ends of remaining **Pieced Borders**. These two **Pieced Borders** should measure 5 ¾-inch x 47 ¾-inch.
 - d. Sew Pieced Borders to top and bottom of **Quilt Center**.
30. Add **Papyrus Border 5**. Sew Papyrus 3-inch x 47 ¾-inch Strips to left side and right side of **Quilt Center**. Then, sew Papyrus 3-inch x 52 ¾-inch Strips to top and bottom of **Quilt Center**.
 31. Press **Quilt**, which should measure 52 ¾-inch square.
 32. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
 33. Sew **Pine Binding** strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Sew to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 
14. Fold **Pine Binding** to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

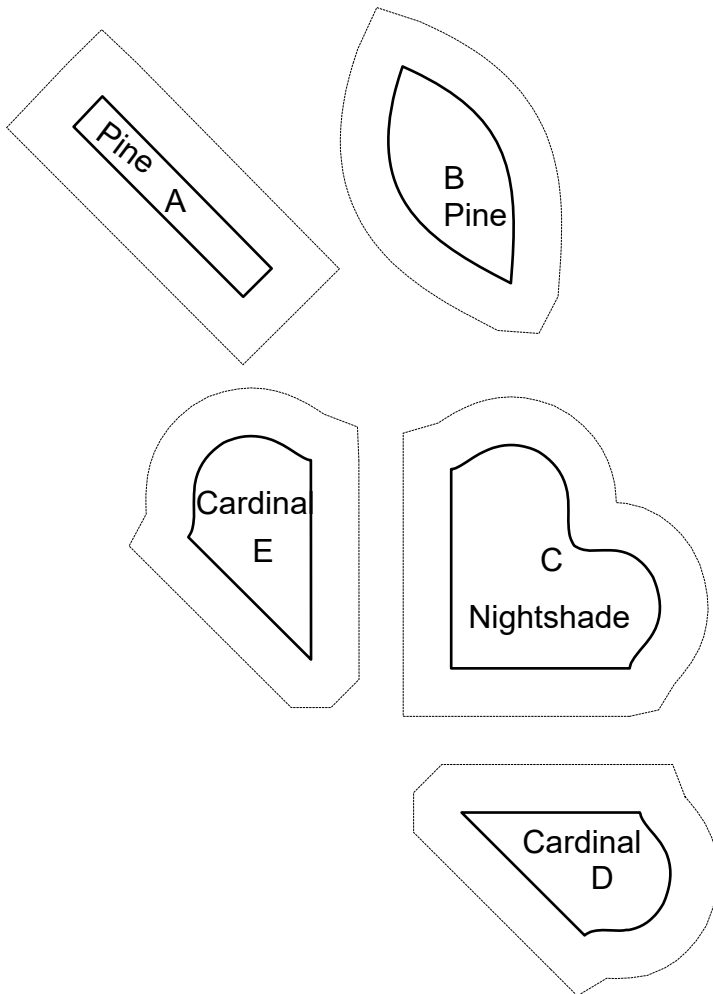
