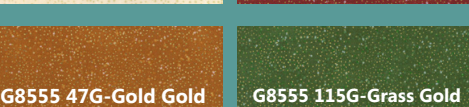

Fabric Requirements

1/3 yard *each*:

G8555 20G-Natural Gold

G8555 115G-Grass Gold

3/8 yard N7541 21G-Teal Gold

7/8 yard *each*:

G8555 39G-Rust Gold

Q7642 20G-Natural Gold

1 yard G8555 47G-Gold Gold (blocks and binding)

1-1/8 yard Q7645 178G-Leaf Gold (border)

1-2/3 yard Q7642 21G-Teal Gold (blocks and border)

3 yards Q7643 20G-Natural Gold (blocks and borders)

6 yards backing fabric of your choice

85" x 97" batting

Cutting

From G8555 Natural Gold:

*Cut two (4-1/4" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut fifteen 4-1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally. (A)

From G8555 Grass Gold

*Cut two (4-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut ten 4-1/2" squares. Cut once diagonally. (B)

From N7541 Teal Gold:

*Cut three (3-7/8" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut thirty 3-7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. (C)

From G8555 Rust Gold:

*Cut four (4-1/4" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut thirty 4-1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally. (D)

*Cut two (4-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut ten 4-1/2" squares. Cut once diagonally. (E)

From Q7642 Natural Gold:

*Cut two (4-3/4" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut fifteen 4-3/4" squares.

*Cut three (5-5/8" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut fifteen 5-5/8" squares.

From G8555 Gold Gold:

*Cut two (4-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut ten 4-1/2" squares. Cut once diagonally. (F)

*Cut nine (2-1/2" x WOF) strips for binding.

From Q7645 Leaf Gold:

*Cut nine (4" x WOF) strips for border.

From Q7642 Teal Gold:

*Cut five (4-1/4" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut forty-five 4-1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally. (G)

*Cut eight (2-1/2" x WOF) strips for second border.

*Cut five (2-7/8" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut sixty 2-7/8" squares.

From Q7643 Natural Gold:

*Cut five (3-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut sixty 3-1/2" squares.

*Cut four (4-1/4" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut thirty 4-1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally. (H)

*Cut twelve (2-7/8" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut sixty 2-7/8" x 7-3/4" rectangles.

*Cut seven (1-1/2" x WOF) strips for first border.

*Cut eight (2-1/2" x WOF) strips for third border.

Block Assembly

All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.

Press seams toward darker fabric otherwise noted.

Block 1



1. Make the diamond in the square block centers by stitching two triangles (C) to two opposing sides of a 4-3/4" Q7642 Natural Gold square. Press open. Stitch two more triangles (C) to the remaining square sides. Press open and trim ears. Make a total of fifteen block centers. (Figure 1).

2. Sew together the (A) and (G) triangles to make sixty half-square triangles. (Figure 2).

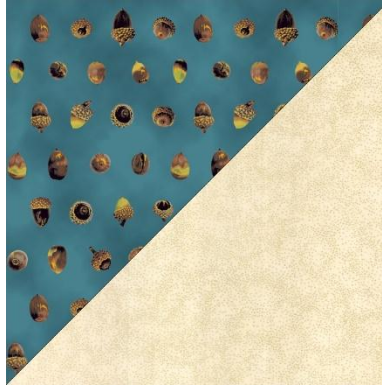

3. Sew a (D) triangle to a (G) triangle. Press open and trim ears. Make sixty units. Sew a (G) triangle a (D) triangle to make another sixty units. (Figure 3)

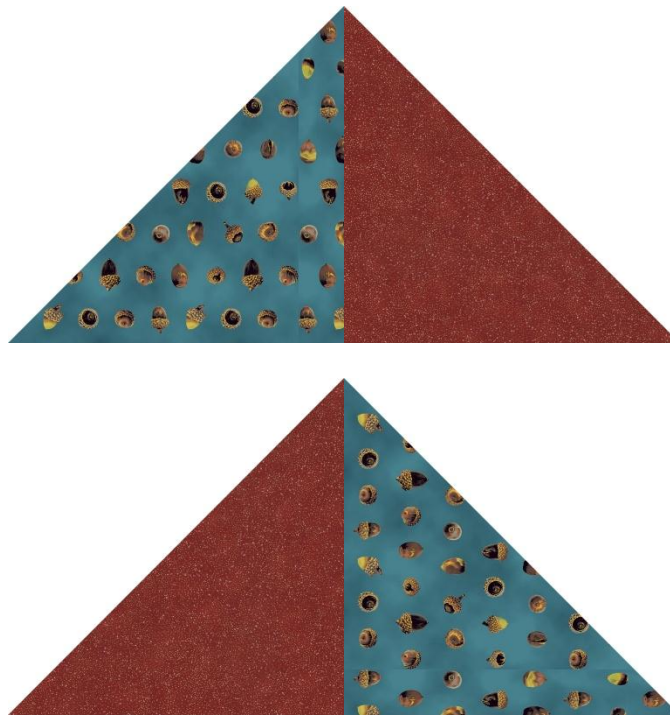

4. Sew two triangles (H) to the two adjacent sides of the acorn side of the HSTs from step 2. (Figure 4). Press open and trim ears. Make sixty units.

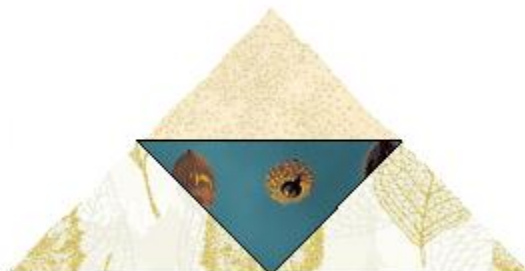

5. Sew the units from step 3 to the units of step 4 as shown below. (Figure 5). Press open and trim ears. Make sixty units.

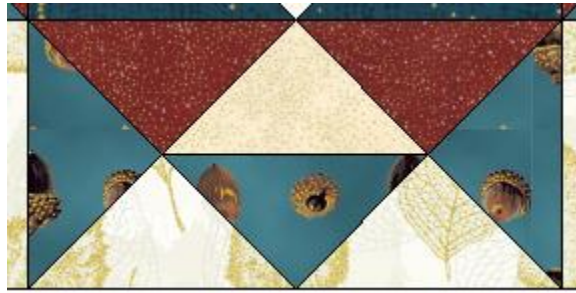

6. Sew two units from step 5 to two opposing sides of the block centers completed in step 1. Press open.

7. Sew two Q7643 Natural Gold 3-1/2" squares to each side of remaining units from step 5. Press. Sew these units to the top and bottom of the block to make fifteen blocks.

Block 2



8. Using the G8555 Rust Gold triangles (E), G8555 Grass Gold triangles (B), and G8555 Gold Gold triangles (F) as well as the Q7642 Natural Gold 5-5/8" squares, make fifteen diamond in the squares as in step 1.

9. Sew two Q7643 Natural Gold 2-7/8" x 7-3/4" rectangles to two opposing sides of the block centers from step 8. Press open. Repeat with all block centers.

9. Sew the Q7642 Teal Gold 2-7/8" squares to the two small sides of the remaining Q7643 Natural Gold 2-7/8" x 7-3/4" rectangles. Press open and sew these units to the top and the bottom of the block centers. Make fifteen blocks – 5 of each color combination.

Quilt Top Assembly

10. Refer to the Quilt diagram below (Figure 4) and lay out six rows of five alternating blocks each (). Stitch the blocks together in each row. Press seams toward the blocks.

11. For the first border, sew seven Q7643 Natural Gold 1-1/2" strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Stitch a border strip to each side of the quilt center and trim the extra length. Press seams toward the border. In the same manner, stitch one border to the top and another to the bottom.

12. Repeat step 11 for the second border using the eight Q7642 Teal Gold 2-1/2" strips.

13. Repeat step 11 for the third border using the eight Q7643 Natural Gold 2-1/2" strips.

14. Repeat step 11 for the fourth border using the nine Q7645 Leaf Gold 4" strips.

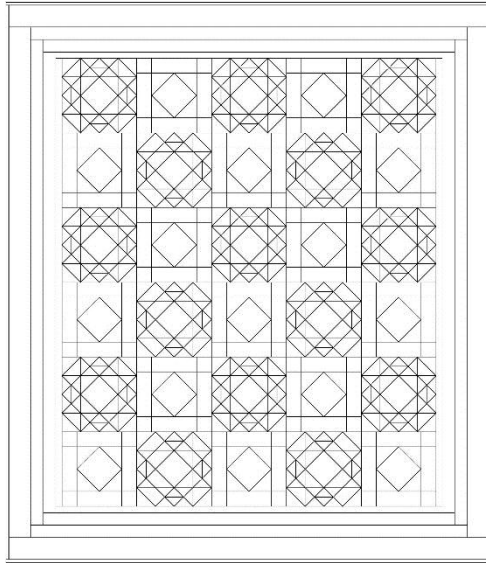

Finishing

15. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
16. Stitch the G8555 Gold Gold binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
17. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
