Good Tidings

Quilt design by Wendy Sheppard

Finished Quilt Size: 65" x 84"

Finished Block Size: 18" x 18"

Cutting Instructions:

Note: Dimensions of patches are listed in W" x L" (important when cutting from directional prints)

From Fabrics 1 & 2, cut from each fabric, for pieced blocks:

(4) 2 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

(2) 3" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (24) 3" x 3" squares.

(2) 3 3/8" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (24) 3 3/8" x 3 3/8" squares.

From Fabrics 3 & 4, cut from each fabric, for pieced blocks:

(8) 2 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (48) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

From Fabrics 5 & 6, cut from each fabric, for pieced blocks:

(1) 6 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. Extra fabric added for fussy cutting.

From Fabrics 7 & 8, cut from each fabric,

For pieced blocks: (4) 3 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (48) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

For binding: Fabric 7 ONLY, cut (8) 2 1/4" WOF.

From Fabric 9, cut for pieced blocks:

(15) 1 1/2" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (48) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" and (48) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

(4) 3" x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (48) 3" x 3" squares.

Cutting for Fabric 9 continued:

(4) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (48) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

For sashing pieces:

(4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" WOF. Sub-cut (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing rectangles.

(5) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strips.

For inner border #1, (7) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $75\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From Fabric 10, cut for outer border, (7) 4" x 42". Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 4" x $65\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 4" x $77\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

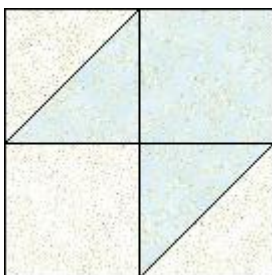
Block Assembly (using blue block as example)

1. Corner unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric 1 square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric 9 square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from drawn line, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield 2 HST units.

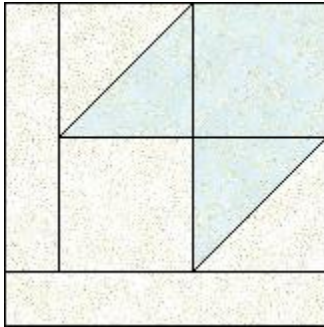


Repeat to make a total of 8 HST units.

Arrange and sew 2 HST units, (1) 3" x 3" Fabric 9 square, and (1) 3" x 3" Fabric 1 square into a 4-patch unit, as shown.



Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 9 rectangle to the left side of sewn unit, followed by (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 9 rectangle to the bottom of sewn unit to complete 1 corner unit.



Repeat to make a total of 4 corner units.

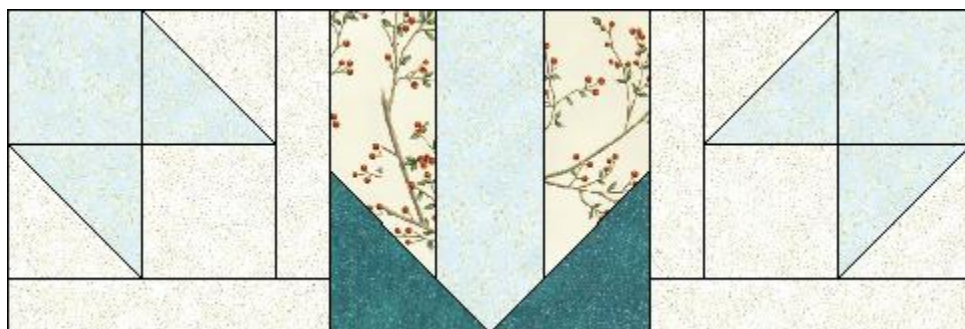
2. Middle units. Sew (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles along the long sides – (2) Fabric 3 and (1) Fabric 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 7 square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of the sewn rectangle unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Open and press to reveal Fabric 7 corner triangle. Repeat with another $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 7 square adjacent to the first corner triangle to complete 1 middle unit.



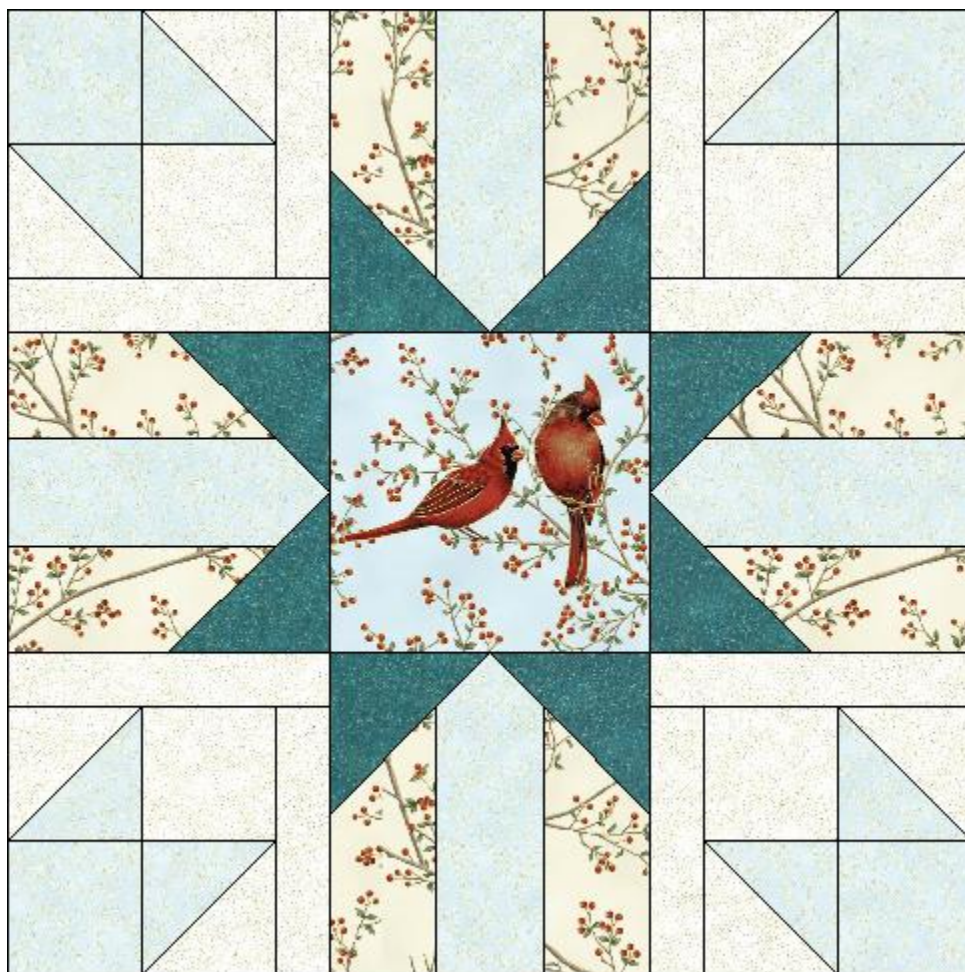
3. Sew 2 middle units to the opposite sides of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 5 square to make a row.



Sew 2 corner units to the opposite sides of 1 middle unit to make a row. Repeat to make 2 rows.



Sew rows together to complete 1 block.



Repeat to make a total of 6 blue and 6 red blocks.

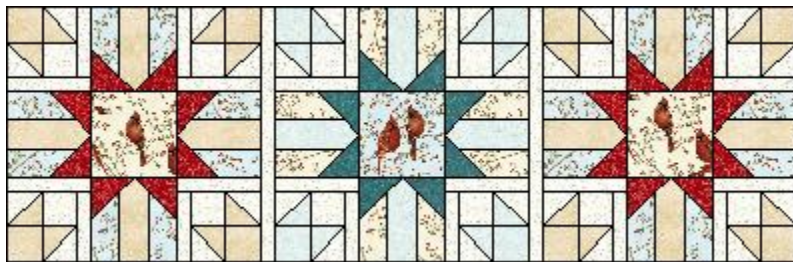
Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced Rows. Arrange and sew together 3 pieced blocks and (2) 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" Fabric 9 sashing rectangles to make a row, as shown.

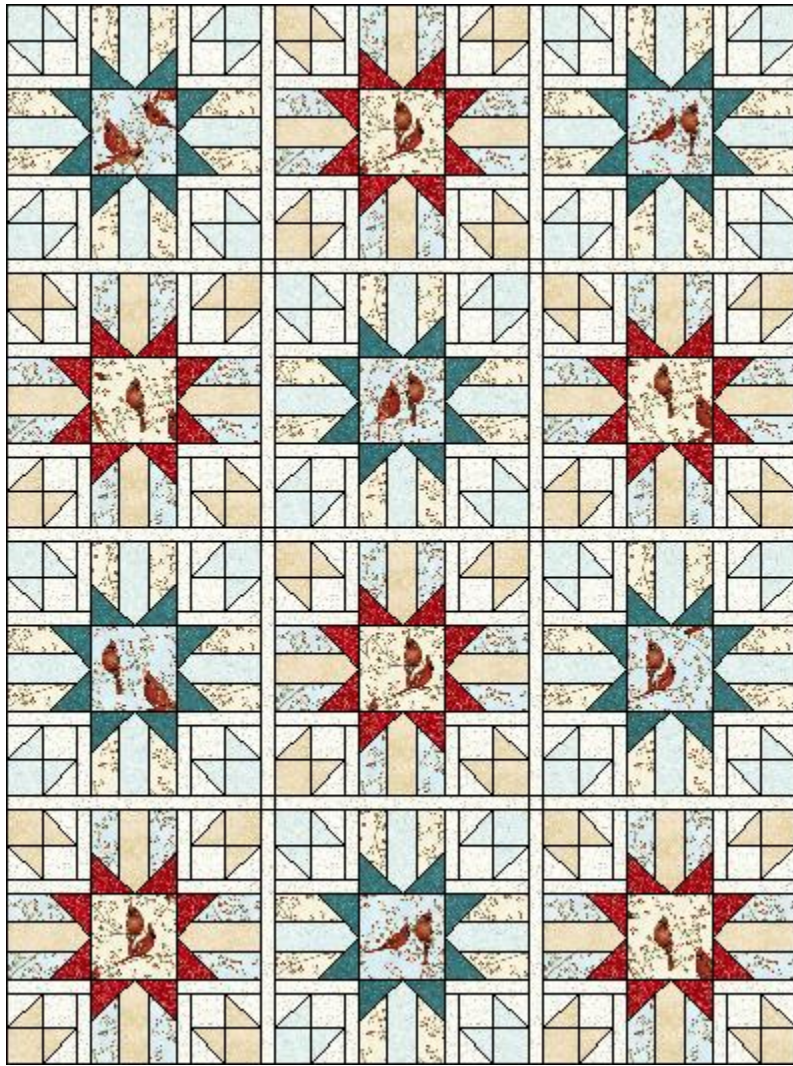
Rows 1&3

2. Sew pieced rows and (3) 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric 9 sashing strips together to complete quilt center. [the sashing strips are cut as whole pieces, and not pieced, as shown in diagram.]



Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" Fabric 9 strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 58 1/2" Fabric 9 strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
2. Outer border. Sew (2) 4" x 77 1/2" Fabric 10 strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 4" x 65 1/2" Fabric 10 strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions:

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to finish quilt.
