Cutting

Label fabrics A-P before cutting and keep in separate piles.

From Fabrics D, J and L, (reds) cut (3) 7 7/8" strips (each) WOF. Sub-cut into 7 7/8" squares.

From Fabrics C and M (whites) cut (2) 7 7/8" strips (each) WOF. Sub-cut into (10) 7 7/8" squares.

From Fabrics H and N (whites) cut (3) 7 7/8" strips (each) WOF. Sub-cut (12) 7 7/8" squares.

From Fabrics G, I and K, (grays) cut (2) 7 7/8" strips (each) WOF. Sub-cut into (8) 7 7/8" squares.

From Fabrics A, B and E, (blacks) cut (2) 7 7/8" strips, (each) WOF and sub-cut into (7) 7 7/8" squares.

From Fabric O cut (7) 1" strips WOF, for inner border.

From Fabric F cut (8) 5 1/2" strips WOF, for outer border.

From Fabric P cut (9) 2 1/2" strips WOF, for binding.

Block Construction Half Square Triangles (HST)

Draw a diagonal line on the back side of all C, H, M and N squares.

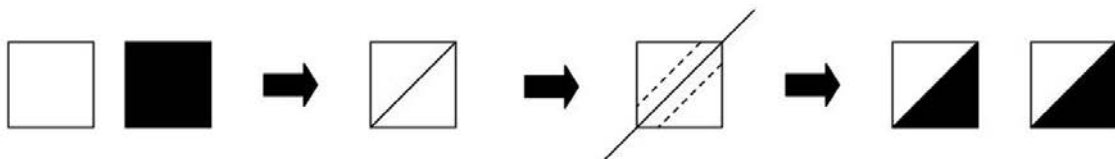
Refer to the accompanying Fabric Pairing Guide for particulars on fabric combinations.

Place two squares of fabric, right sides together and stitch a scant 1/4inch away from both sides of the drawn line. Be mindful of the print direction in the Fabric A (bird house) and Fabric N (cardinal) designs. Refer to the quilt photo for reference.

Once your *white with red* and *white with black/gray* blocks are sewn, continue with the *red and black/gray* combos. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of the red squares.

Place the appropriate squares together (RST) and stitch a scant 1/4 inch away from both sides of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line. Each pair will yield 2 HST units. See diagram below.



The blocks should measure 7 1/2”.

Quilt Construction

Refer to the quilt image for block placement/correct layout. All seams are $1/4$ ". There will be 10 blocks per row. Piece 10 rows total. Sew the rows together.

Once your quilt center is pieced, you can start adding the inner borders. Sew the (7) 1" WOF strips together at short ends.

Determine and label the top of the quilt. Use the birdhouse and cardinals as a guide, making sure they are right side up.

Fold the quilt center in half, top to bottom. Measure from fold to where the top and bottom edges meet, through the middle. Double this amount and cut (2) 1" strips to this measurement.

Sew one strip to the left and one to the right sides of the quilt center.

Fold the quilt in half, but this time left to right. Measure from the fold, through the middle, to the left and right edges. Double this measurement and cut the remaining 1" strips for two more inner borders. Sew one strip to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center.

For the outer border, sew all (8) $5\ 1/2$ " strips together at short ends. Again fold quilt in half, top to bottom and measure through the middle. Double that amount and cut to that measurement, for the left and right side outer borders. Attach.

Then fold the quilt in half lengthwise, left to right. Measure from fold to edges, double this amount and cut for the top and bottom borders. Attach.

Sandwich the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired.

Join together the $2\ 1/2$ " binding strips and bind using your favorite method.
