# Into the Wild

Quilt instructions by Linda Ambrosini

Finished Size 52 by 68 inches

This quilt is divided into 4 sections. The top left hand section includes the raccoon block and framing colors. The bottom left section contains the deer block. The bottom right is the fox section and finally the top right is a group of multi-colored blocks. Please refer to the quilt's photograph for extra color and placement verification.

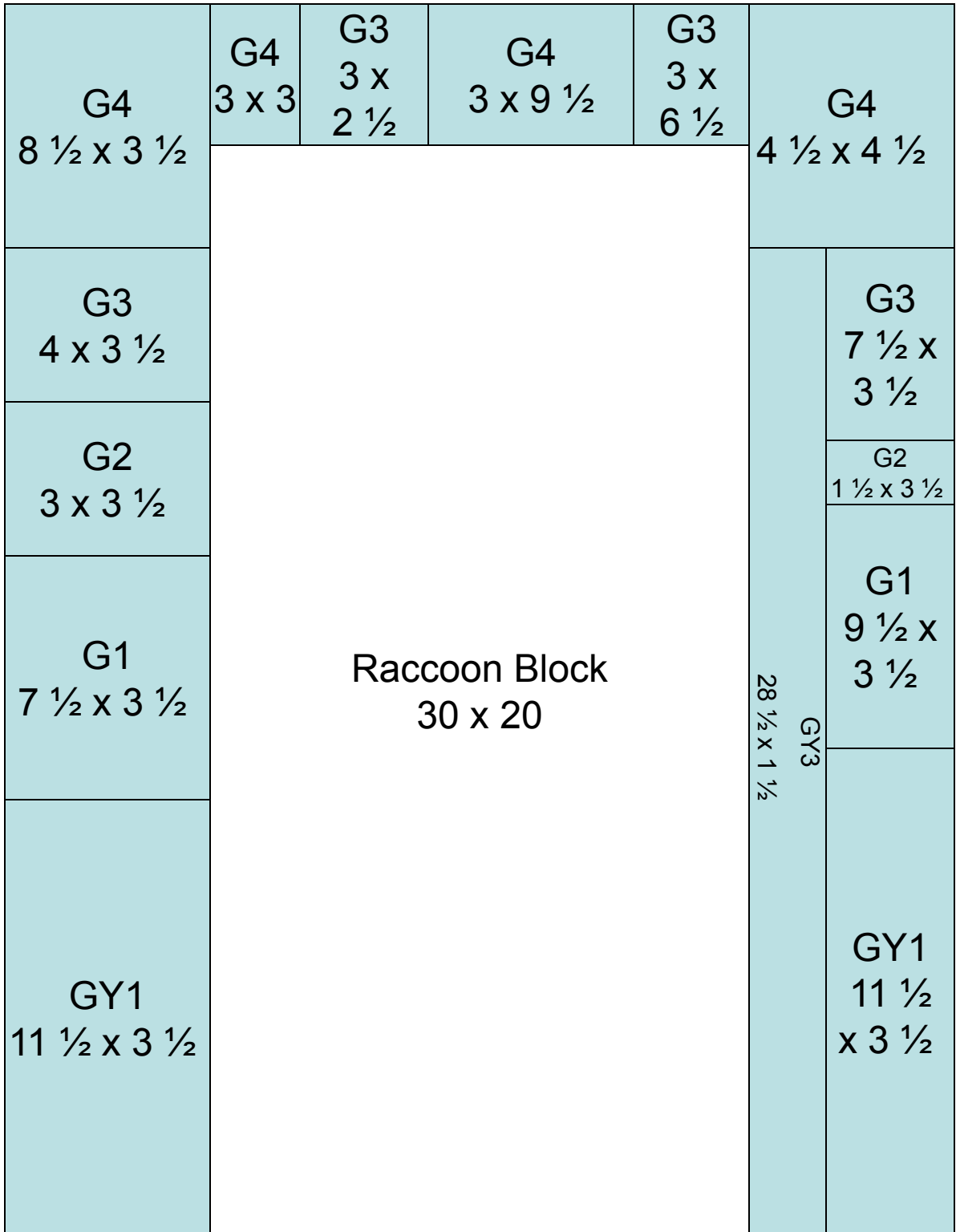
The quilt section diagrams are not drawn to scale.

All dimensions given are the cutting dimension for each unit, with the vertical dimension given first and the horizontal second.

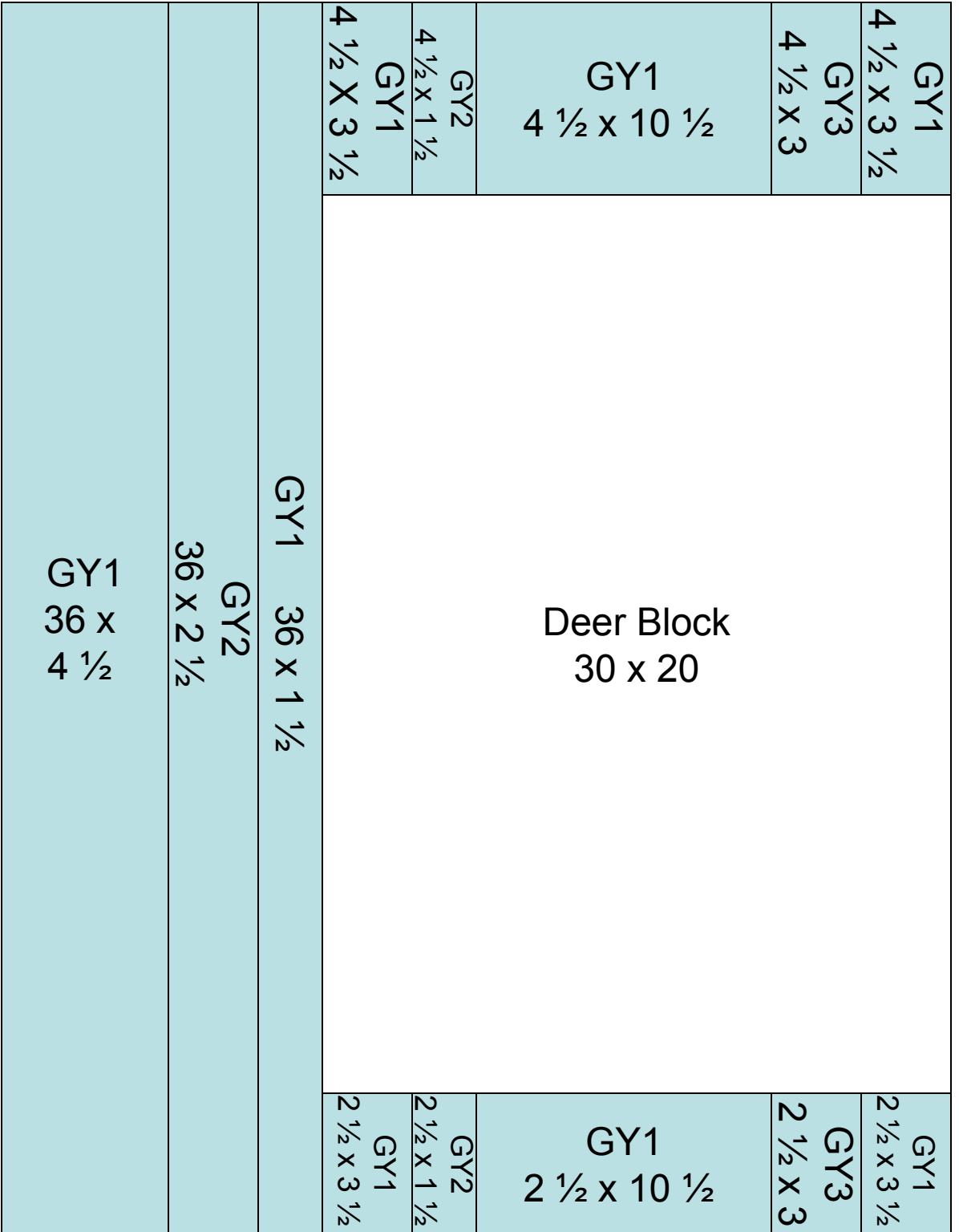
To conserve fabric we suggest that any measurement over 8" be cut crosswise.

When cutting your fabric, start by cutting a WOF strip of the largest dimensions first. For example G4's largest dimension is found in the upper right hand area of the multi-colored upper right section. It measures 6 ½ by 4 ½ inches. Cut a 6 ½ by WOF strip. The next largest unit for G4 is in the same block which is 6 ¼ by 9. Cut this unit next from your 6 ½ by WOF strip. Continue cutting in this manner. Some of your long narrow pieces like GY1, in the deer block, you will want to cut a crosswise or a WOF strip to that dimension. For example, cut a 4 ½ inch strip and then cut the 36 inch length. Save the remainder of that piece as you may use it somewhere else in the quilt, like in that same block on the bottom where you need some smaller GY1's.
