



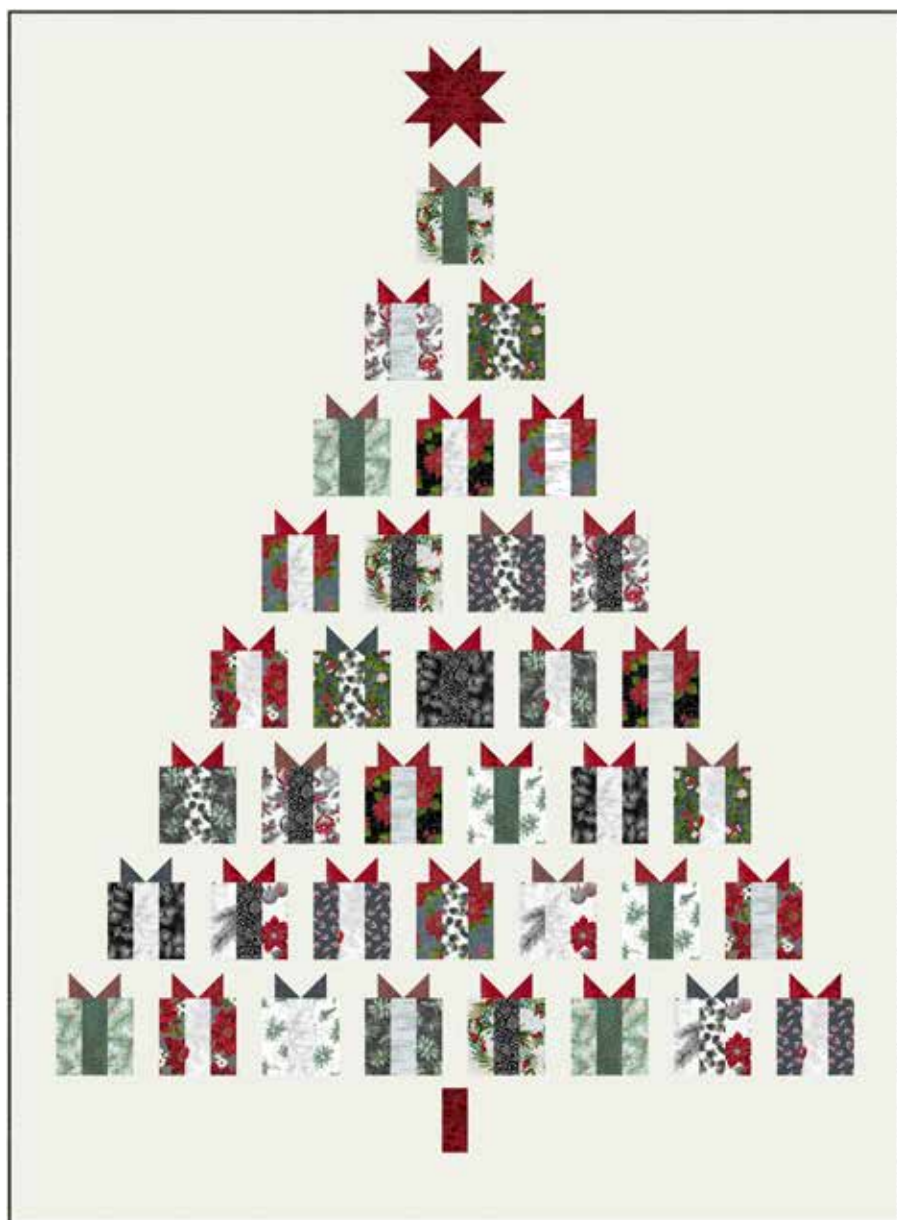

Fabrics and Cutting Chart

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Directions
 T4878-307 Snow	5 1/4y	<p>a. Patch (background) blocks (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (2) 8 1/2" x 24 1/2" and (2) 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>(2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (2) 8 1/2" x 20 1/2" and (2) 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>(6) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 8 1/2" x 28 1/2" and (2) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles; and (2) 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" squares.</p> <p>b. Gift blocks (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>c. Tree trunk block (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2", and (2) 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>d. Star block (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares and (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>e. Sashing strips (15) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and sub-cut (9) 1 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips.</p> <p>f. Outer border (8) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 3" x 69 1/2" and (2) 3" x 89 1/2" strips.</p>

(1) 40-ply of Jingle Pops 2 ½" strip set

Quilters will choose their strips of choice for cutting the following pieces for a scrappy effect of quilt design.

(5) strips for gift bow pieces: (4) red and (1) gray	Cut (16) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares from each of red strips, and (8) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares from gray strip.
(1) red strip	Cut (12) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares for star block, and (1) 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle for tree trunk block.
(18) strips for gift boxes	Cut from each strip (6) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles for a total of (108) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.
(10) strips	Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.

Constructing Gift Blocks

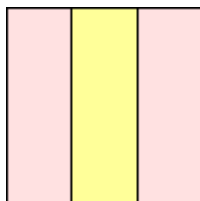
1. Flying Geese unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" gift bow squares. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" **background** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 2 ½" x 2 ½" gift bow square at the opposite corner of the same **background** rectangle to make (1) Flying Geese unit. Unit measures 2 ½" x 4 ½" unfinished.



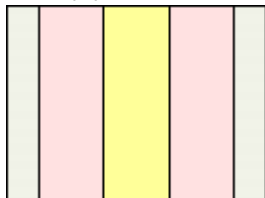
Add (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" **background** squares to the opposite short sides of flying geese unit.



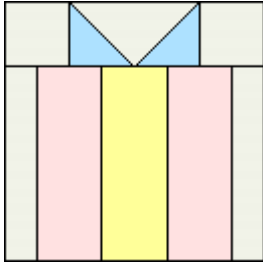
2. Sew (1) pair of 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" of a different fabric.



Add (2) 1 ½" x 6 ½" **background** rectangles to the left and right sides.

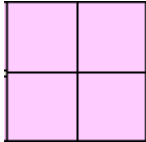


3. Sew Step 1 unit to the top of Step 2 unit to complete (1) gift block. Block measures $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished. Make a total of (36) gift blocks.



Constructing Star Block

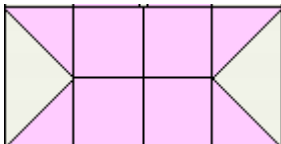
1. Sew together (4) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ *red* squares to make a 4-patch block center.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ *red* square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ *background* rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ *red* square at the opposite corner of the same *background* rectangle to make (1) Flying Geese unit. Unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished. Make a total of (4) Flying Geese units.



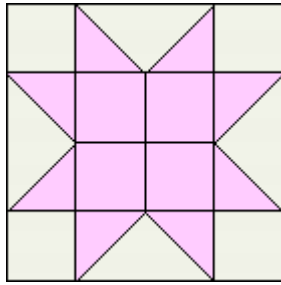
3. Sew (2) Flying Geese units to the left and right sides of block center to make a row unit.



4. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ *background* squares to the opposite short sides of (1) Flying Geese unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.

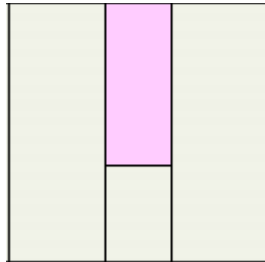


5. Sew row units made in Steps 3-4 to complete star block. Block measures $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished.



Constructing Tree Trunk Block

1. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$ **red** rectangle to the top of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** rectangle. Add (2) $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** rectangles to the left and right sides to complete tree trunk block. Block measures $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished.



Quilt Top Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image block placement guide, arrange and sew together pieced blocks and appropriate patch blocks to make a piece row. Make a total of (10) pieced rows.

Row 1: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 28\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (1) star block

Row 2: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 28\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (1) gift block

Row 3: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 24\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (2) gift blocks

Row 4: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 20\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (3) gift blocks

Row 5: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (4) gift blocks

Row 6: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (5) gift blocks

Row 7: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (6) gift blocks

Row 8: (2) $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (7) gift blocks

Row 9: (8) gift blocks

Row 10: (2) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 28\frac{1}{2}"$ **background** patch blocks and (1) tree trunk block

2. Sew pieced rows together along the long sides, alternating with $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 64"$ **background** sashing strips to complete quilt center.

3. Outer border. Sew (2) 3" x 89 1/2" **background** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3" x 69 1/2" **background** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
