Vintage Farmhouse Placemats and Napkins

Placemat measures 19" x 16" finished

Napkin finishes at 18"

Please note that the quantity of fabric given is enough for 4 sets

For each placemat:

Of MRD10 Sepia, cut one piece 12"x 10".

Cut one piece of the tile, MRD15 Ivory 10 ½" x 5 ½ and fold in half, wrong sides together, so one square tile is showing. (There will be another tile on the back side. This is your napkin pocket.)

Baste the pocket to a 12 x 5 ½ piece of MRD9 Robin's Egg (fussy cut so the hydrangea is showing on the top of the piece cut).

Then, sew this hydrangea and pocket piece to the left side of the 12" x 10" Sepia rectangle.

Cut 2 strips 2 ½" by WOF of the MRD13-Vintage for the borders. Sew the borders to the top, bottom and sides of the placemat.

Add batting and backing to the placemat. Quilt, being sure to not to quilt where the pocket is. Only quilt the hydrangea, the 12 x 10 section, and the borders.

After quilting, bind with the MRD12 Woody...cut 2 strips 2 ½ x LOF.

Napkin - cut one strip of the ombré MRD16-Celadon- 18 ½ x 37. Fold in half to make an 18 ½ x 18 ½ square. Sew, right sides together, leaving a 3" opening to turn right side out. Press and stitch close to edge.
